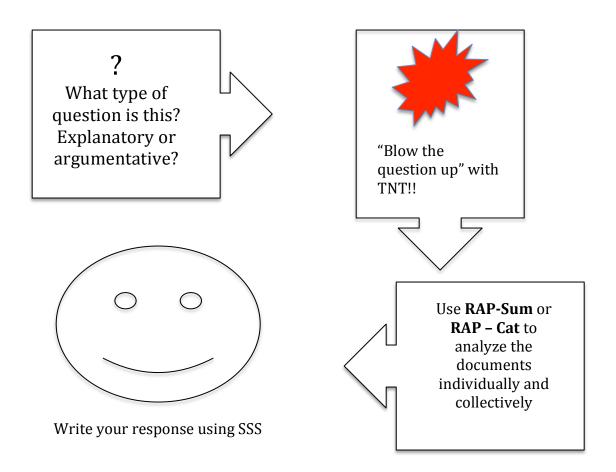
Procedure for responding to DBQs

- 1. Determine the type of DBQ question is it <u>explanatory</u> (asking you to explain some event or phenomena presented in through the documents) or <u>argumentative</u> (asking you to take and defend a position based on the documents).
- 2. Read the question prompt carefully and break the question down ("blow it up") using the TNT strategy. This will help search purposefully for certain things in the DBQ.
- 3. Read the documents for the DBQ and analyze them using either RAP-Sum (for explanatory DBQs) or the RAP-Cat (for argumentative). Be sure your analysis is related to the question prompt.
- 4. Write your response using the SSS strategy. Be sure to address all areas of the question as identified in the TNT analysis of the question prompt.
