- Documentation workroom

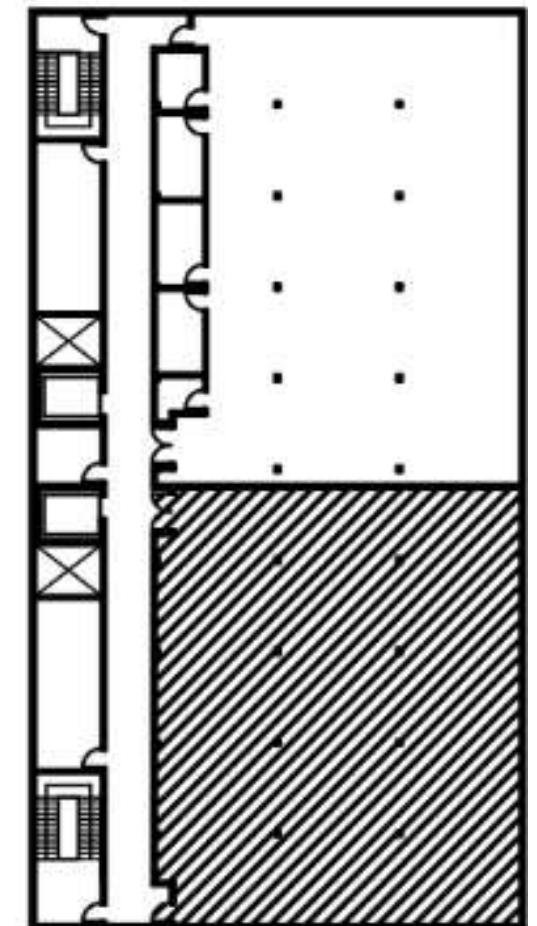
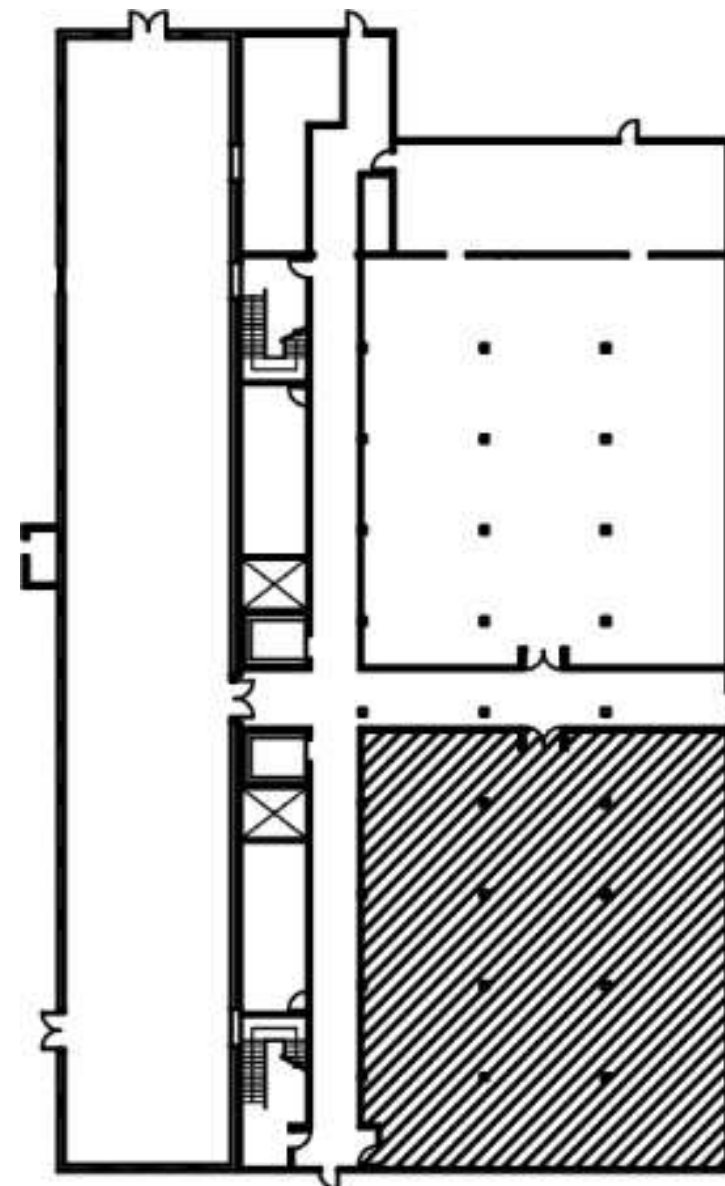

Research

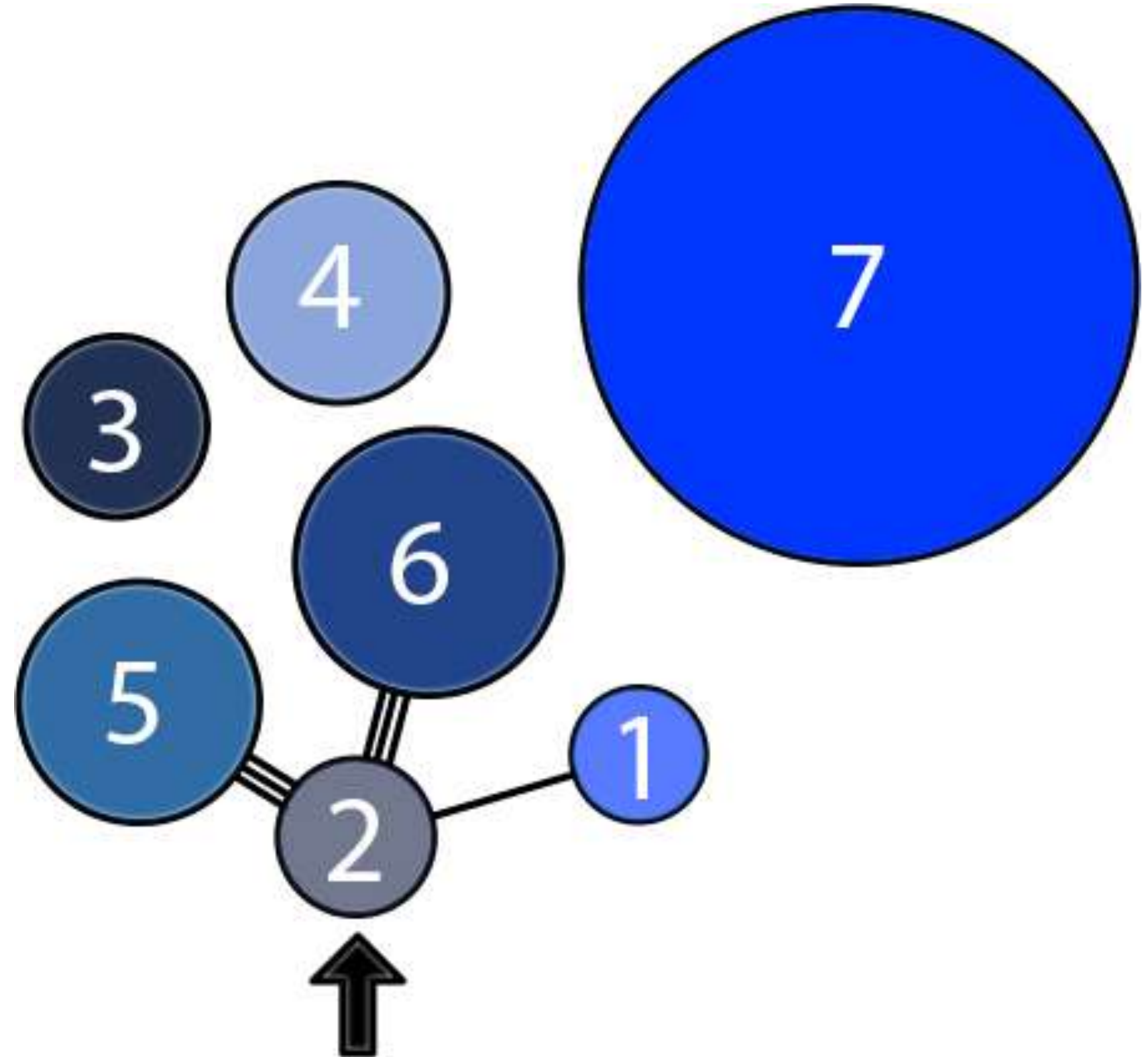
North Carolina Department of Natural and Cultural Resources

- The NCDR oversees resources for libraries, arts, history, and nature
- Has 89 locations it oversees including 27 historic sites, and 39 state parks
- The historical program has been around since 1903, it is now called the Office of Archives and History or the OAH
- The mission of the OAH is “To collect, preserve, and utilize the state’s historic resources so that present and future residents may better understand their history”
- The OAH can be broken down into 4 categories, Archeology, Highway Markers Program, Historic Preservation, and Historical Publications
- In the archives there are surveys of all historic buildings

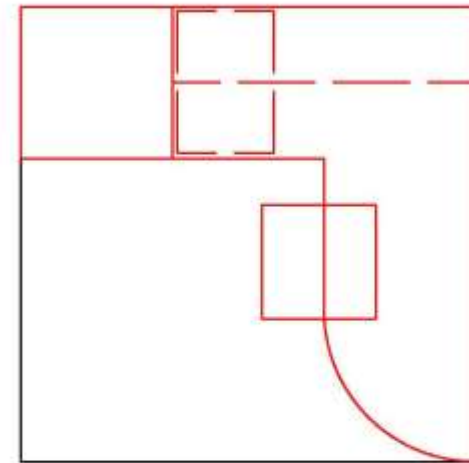
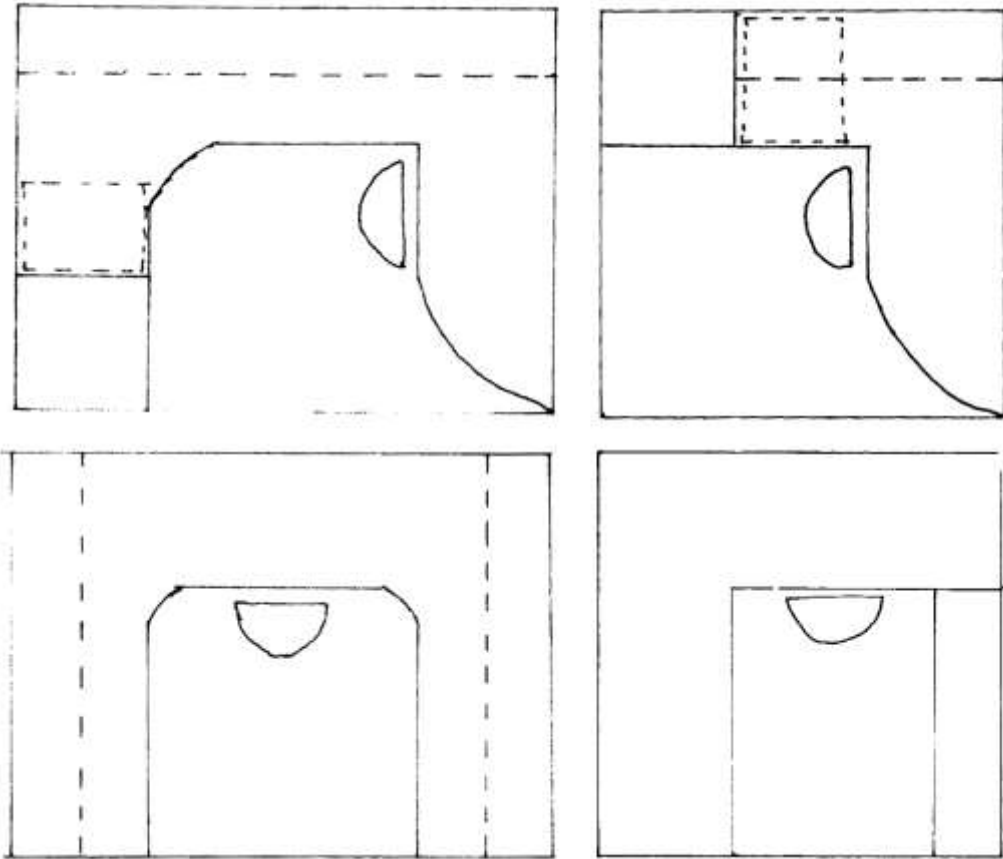
1. Director and Assistant Offices – 338.8 ft²

7. Visiting Fellows and Guest Research – 4,472.2 ft²



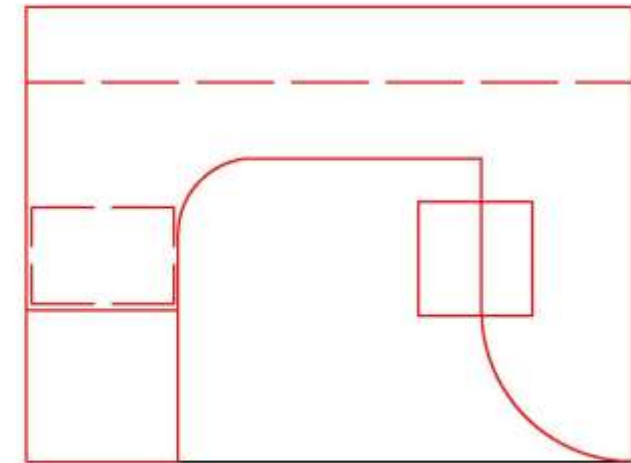
Blocking Diagram



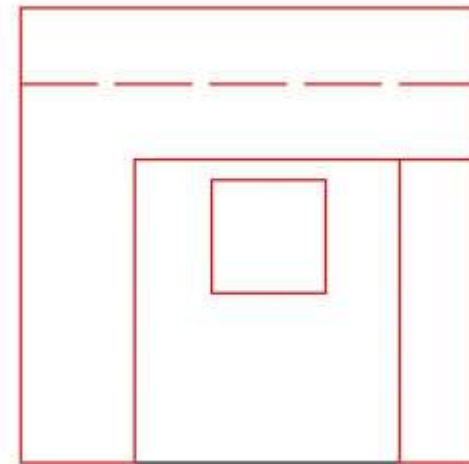

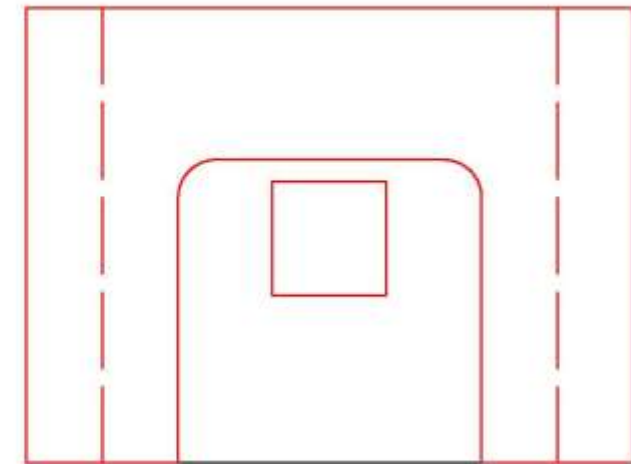

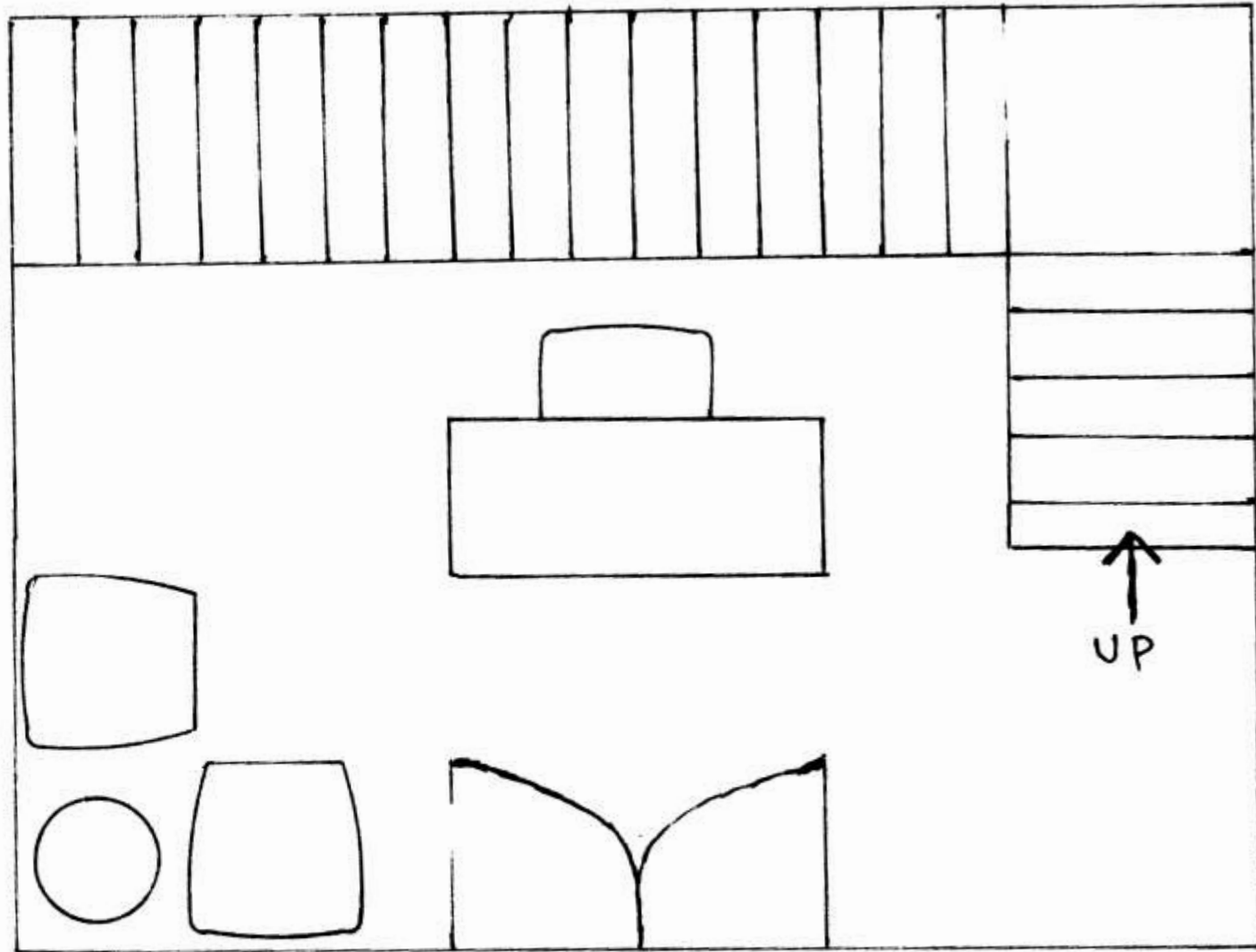

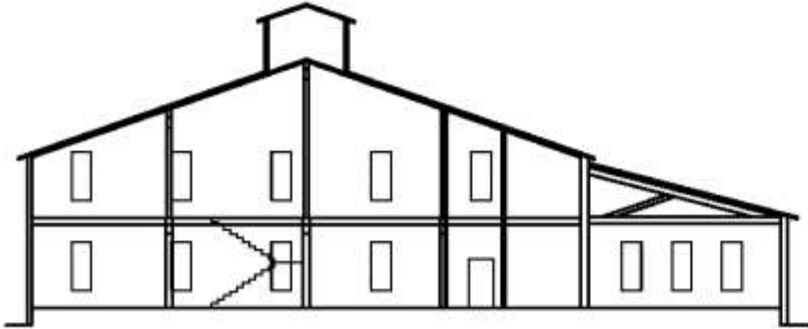
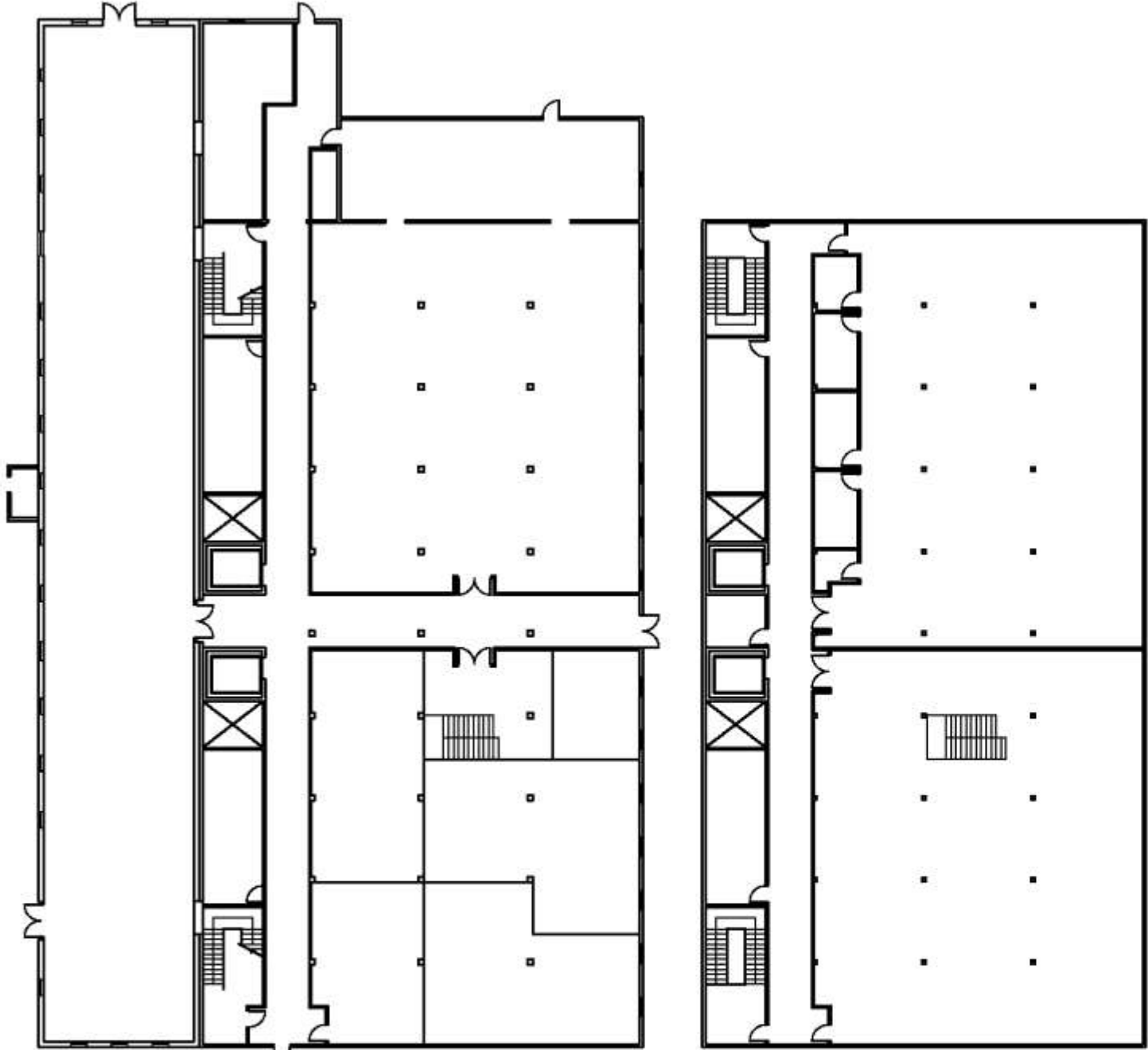
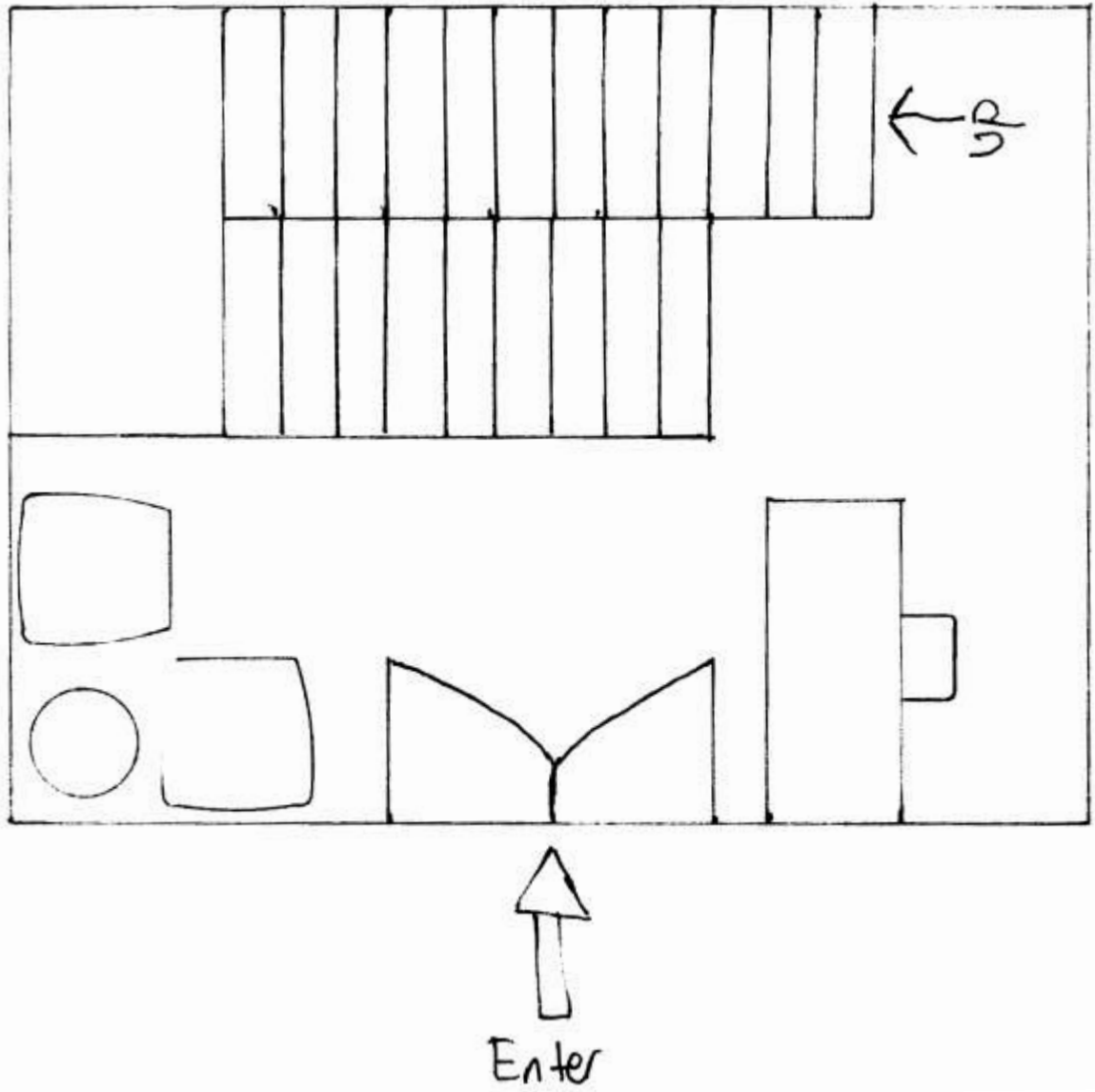
L-Shaped Stair Plan View



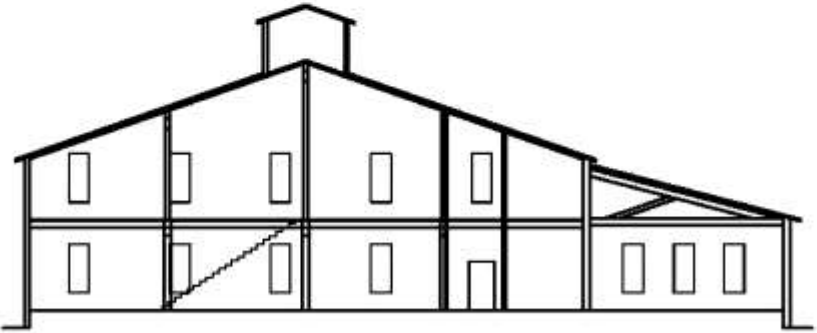
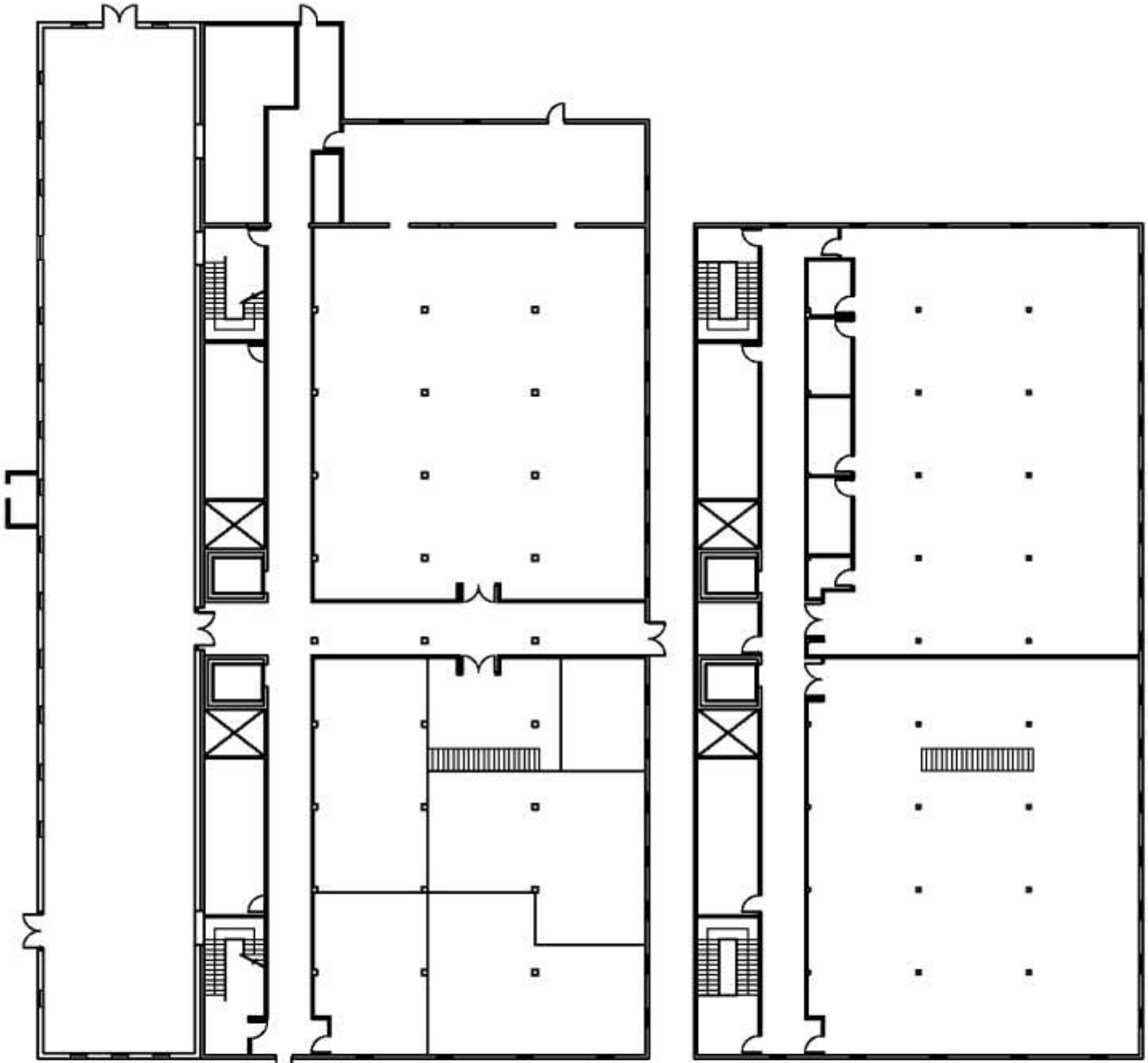
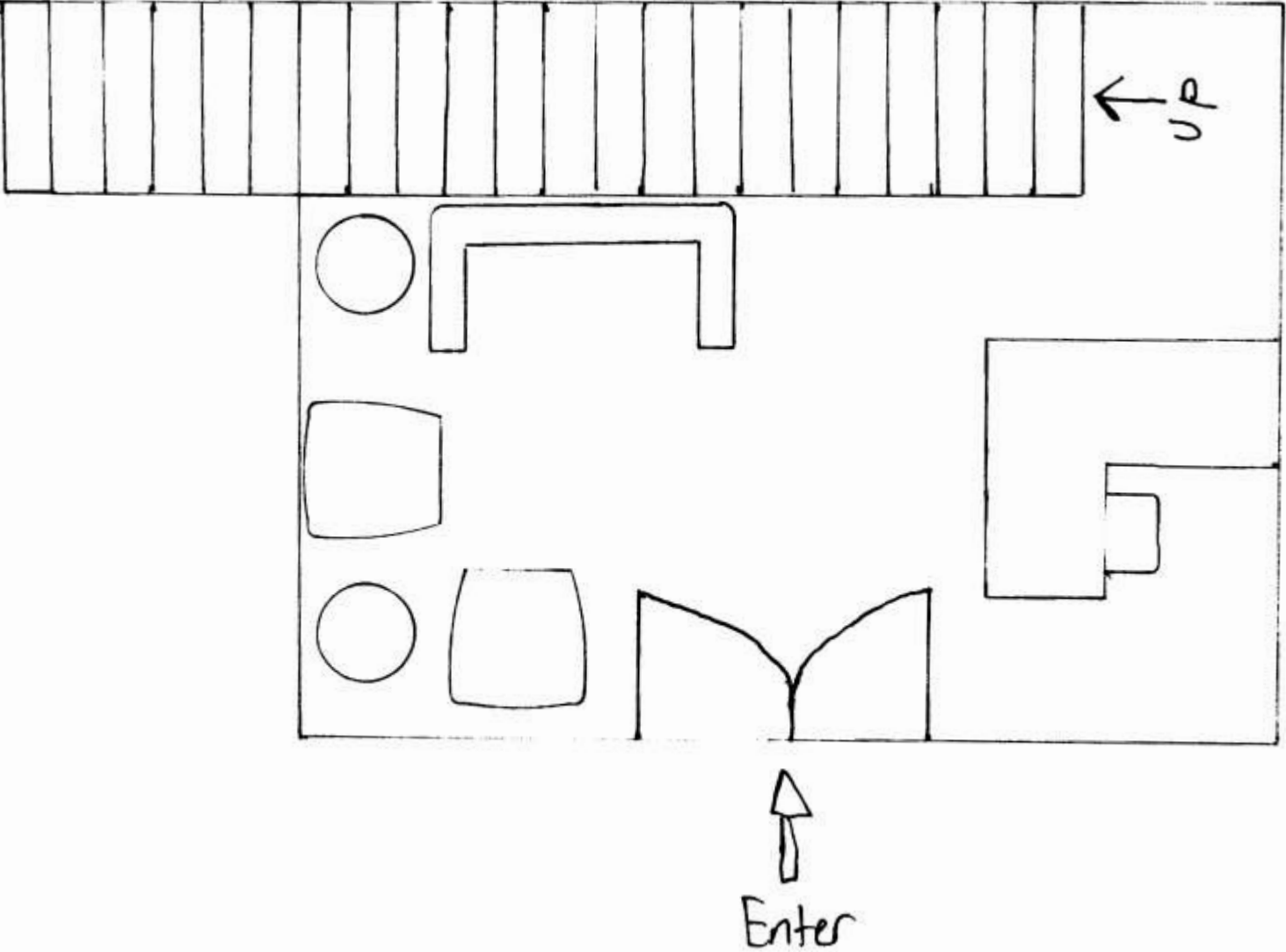
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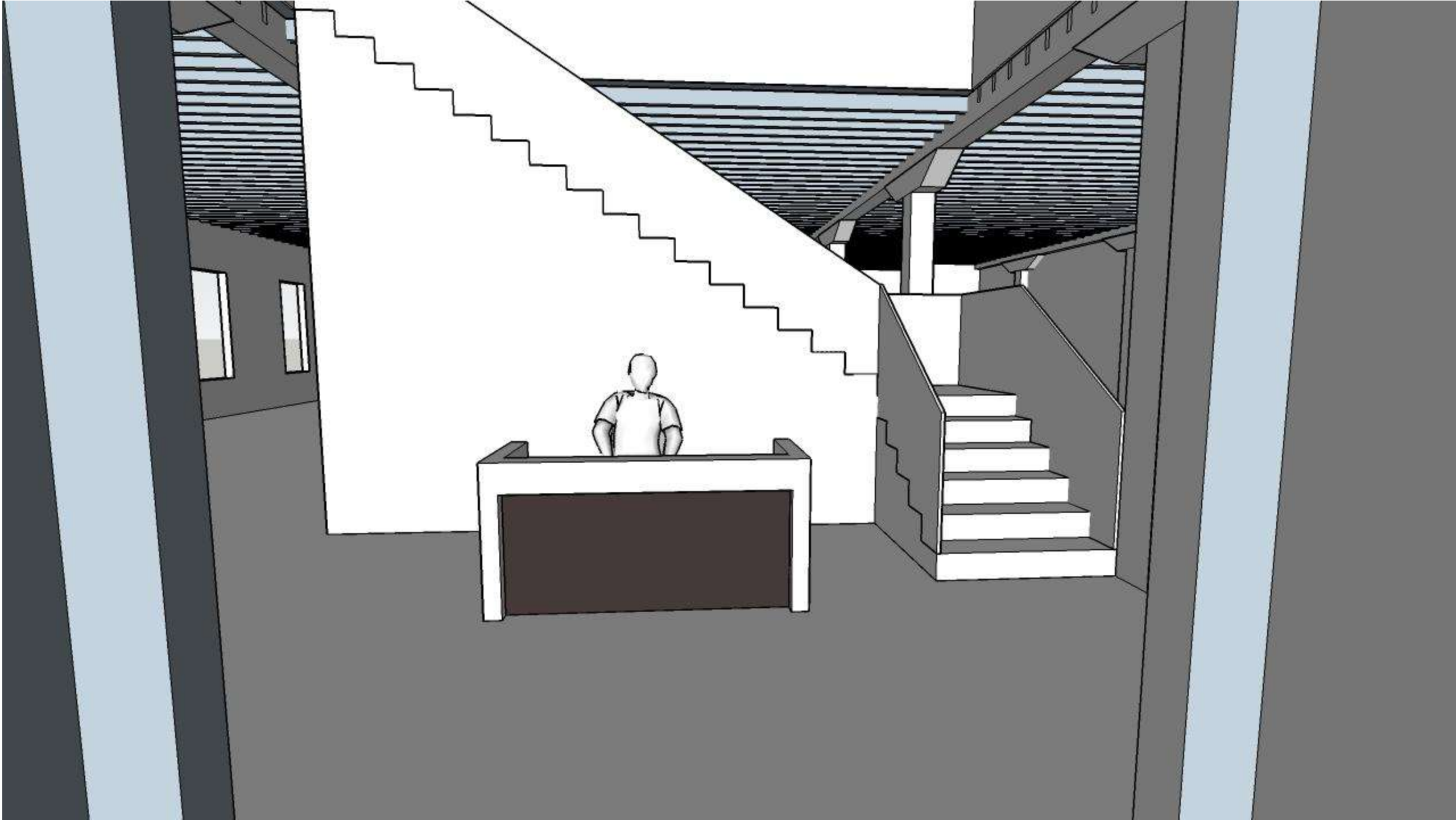
Scissor Stair Plan View



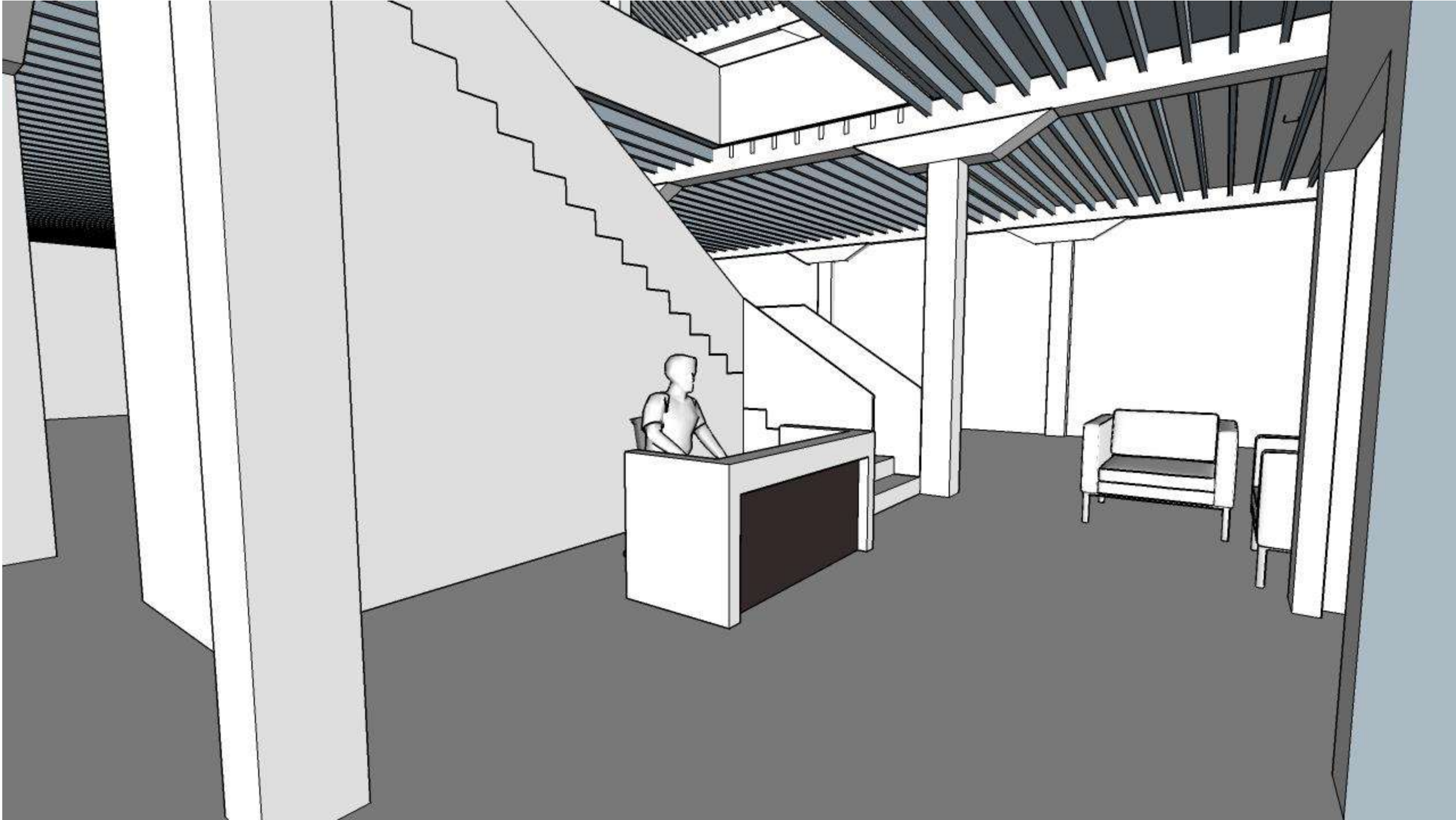
Straight Stair Plan View



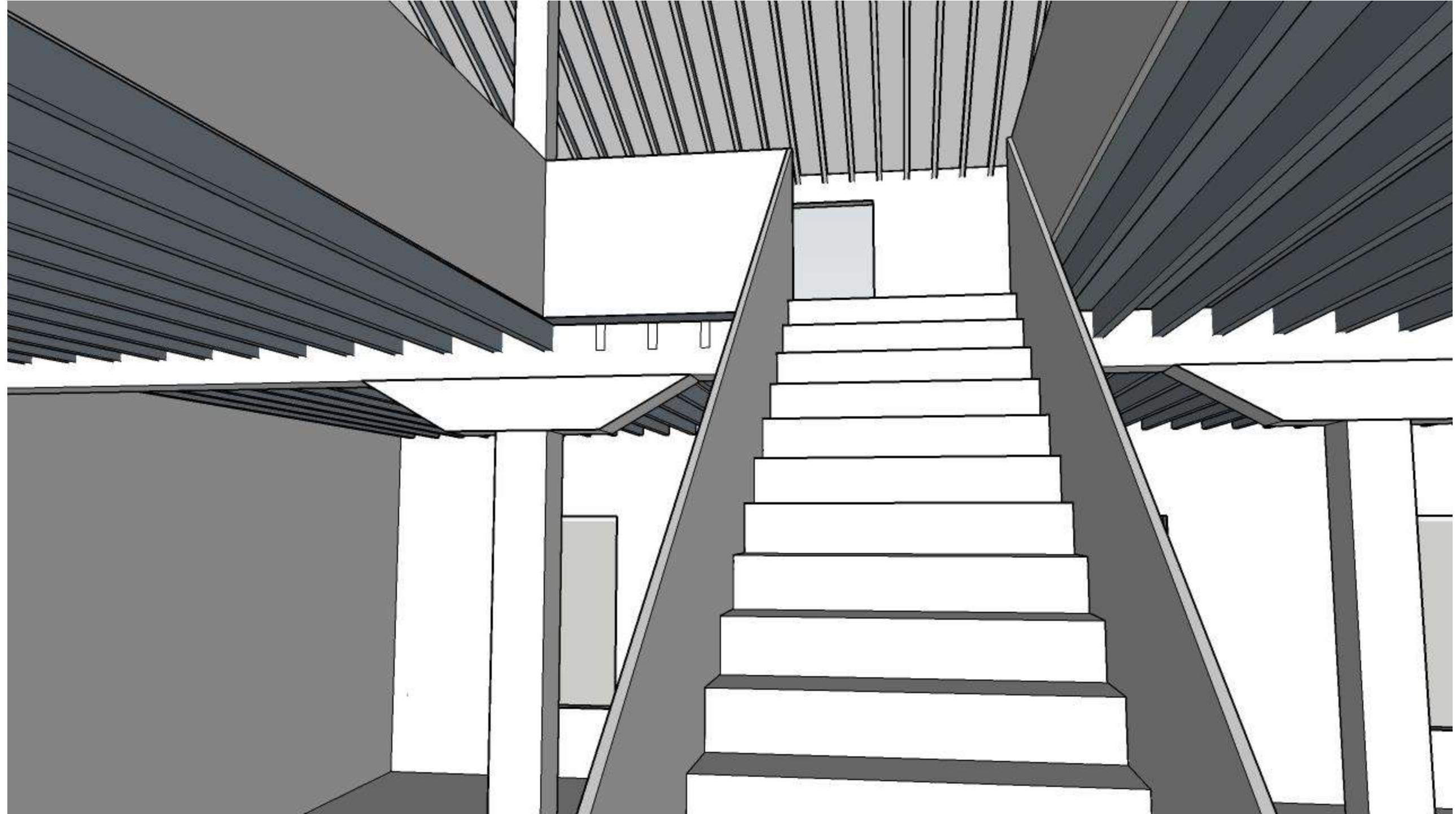

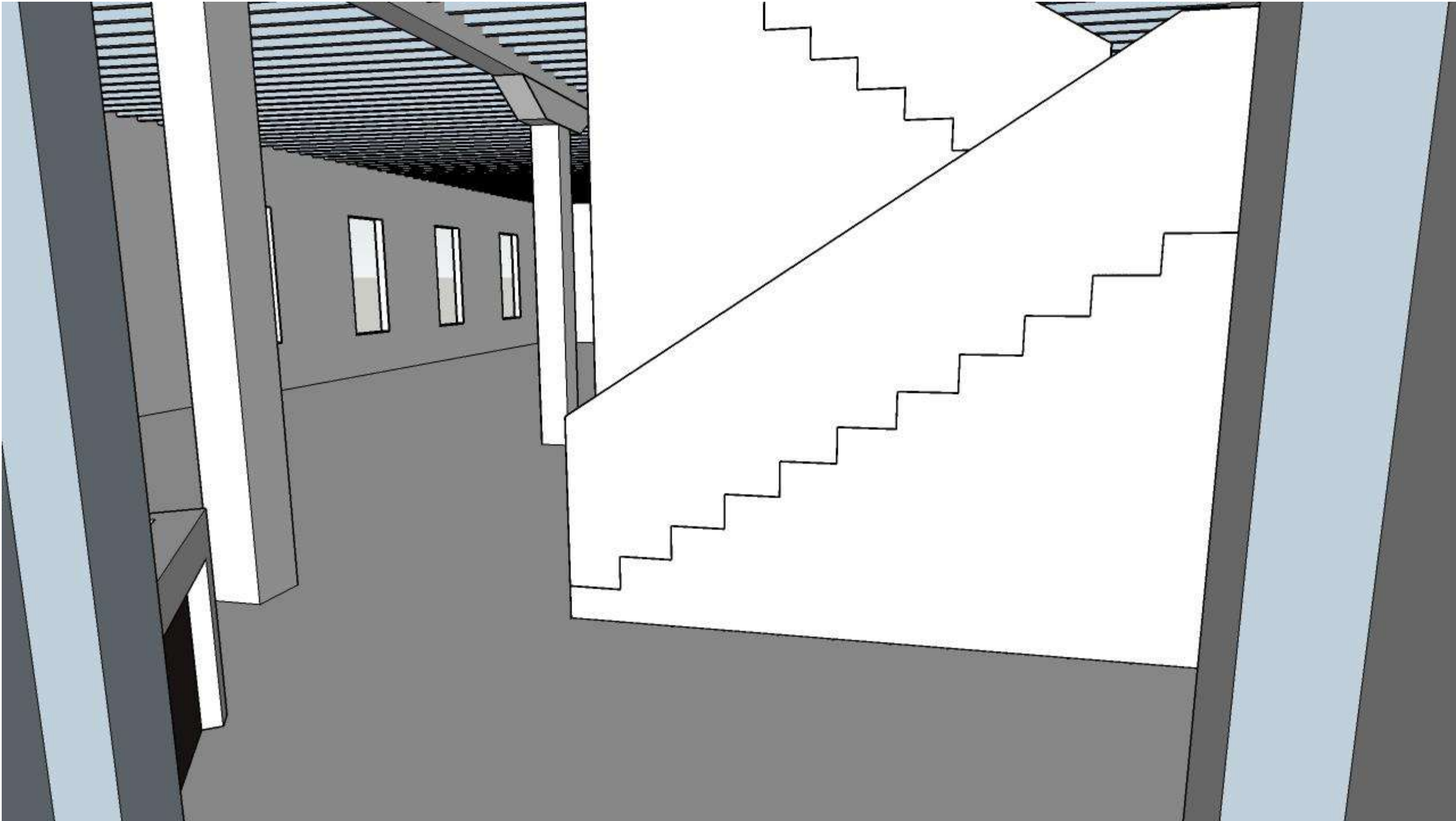

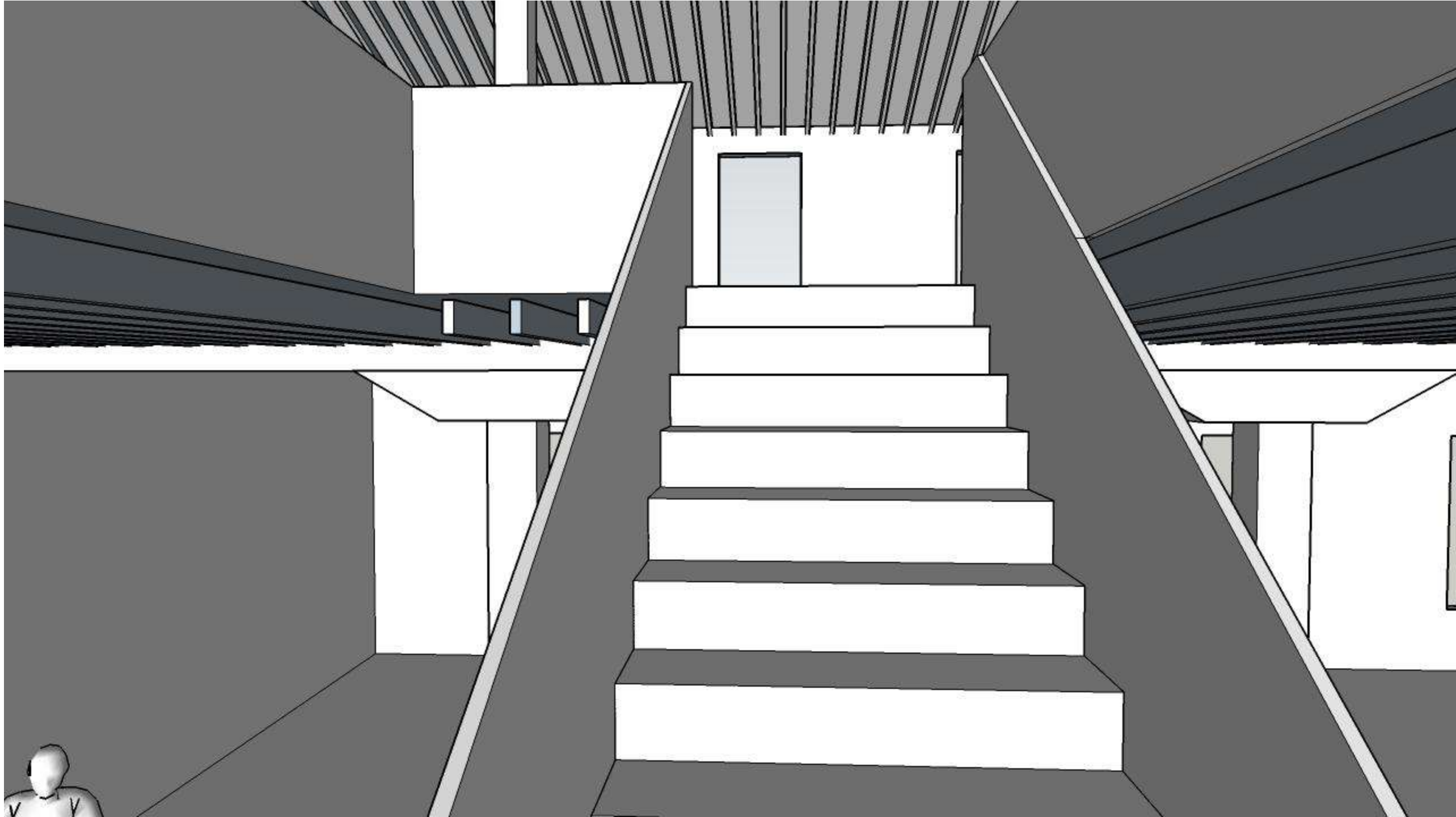

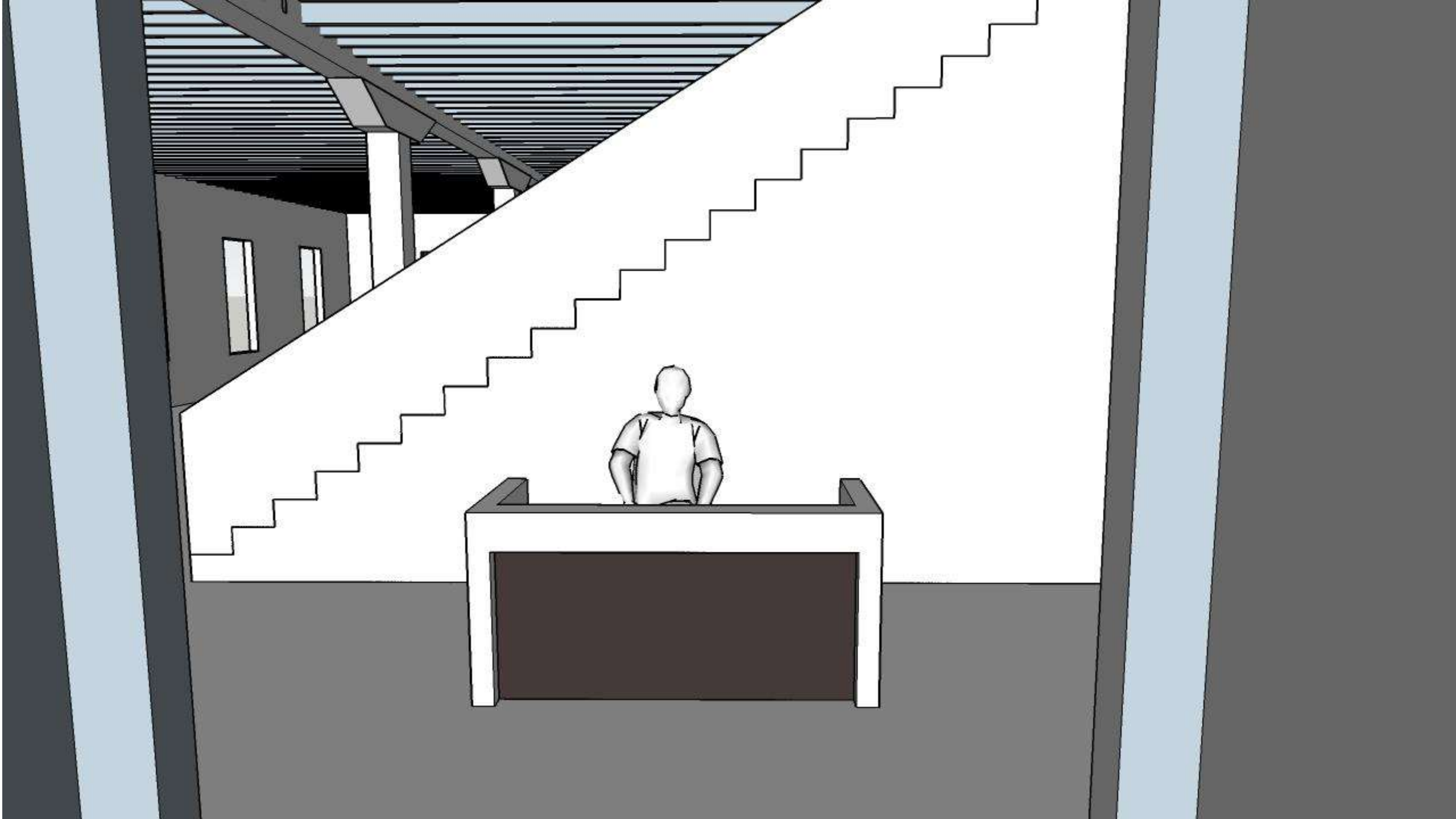

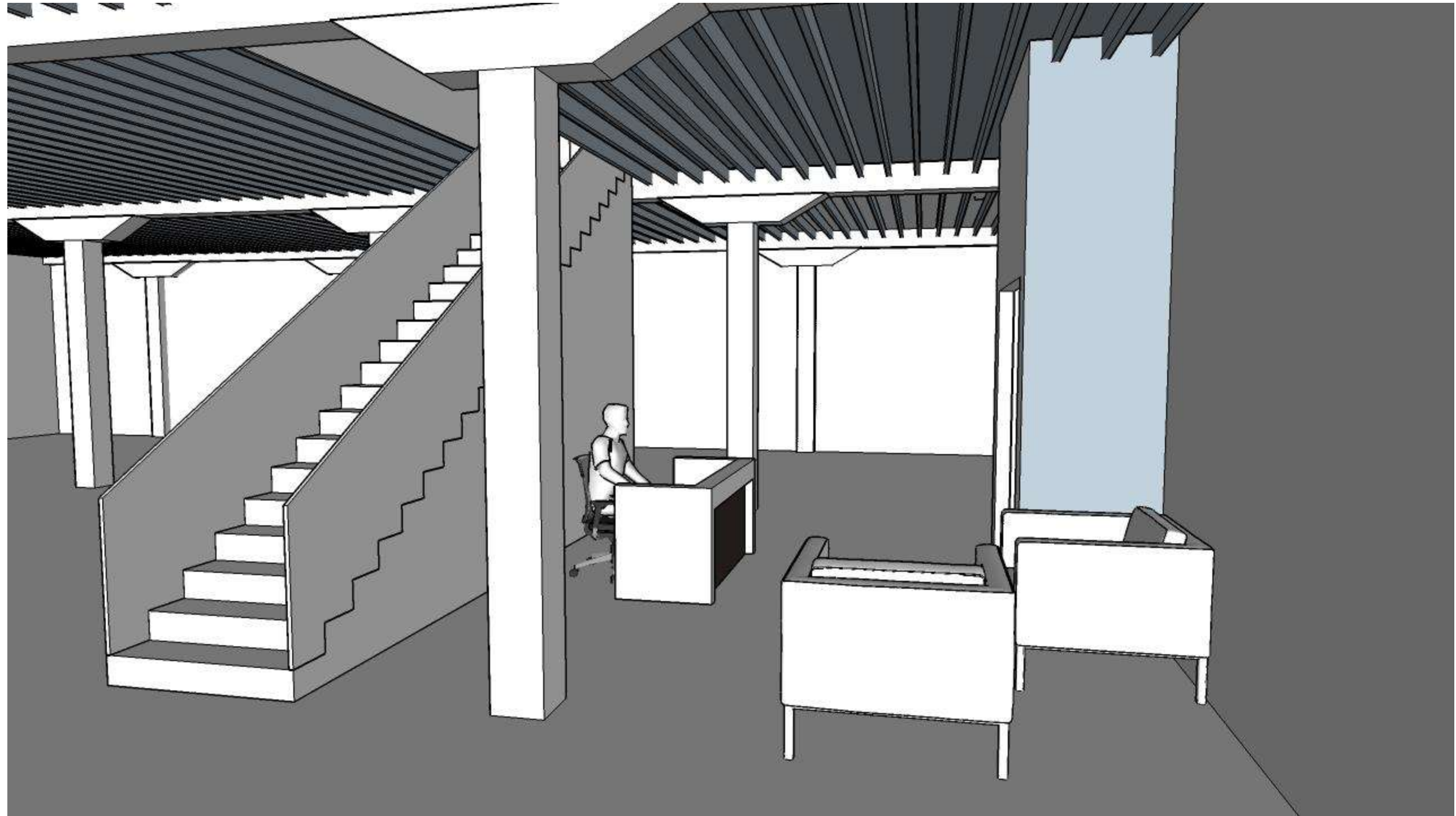
