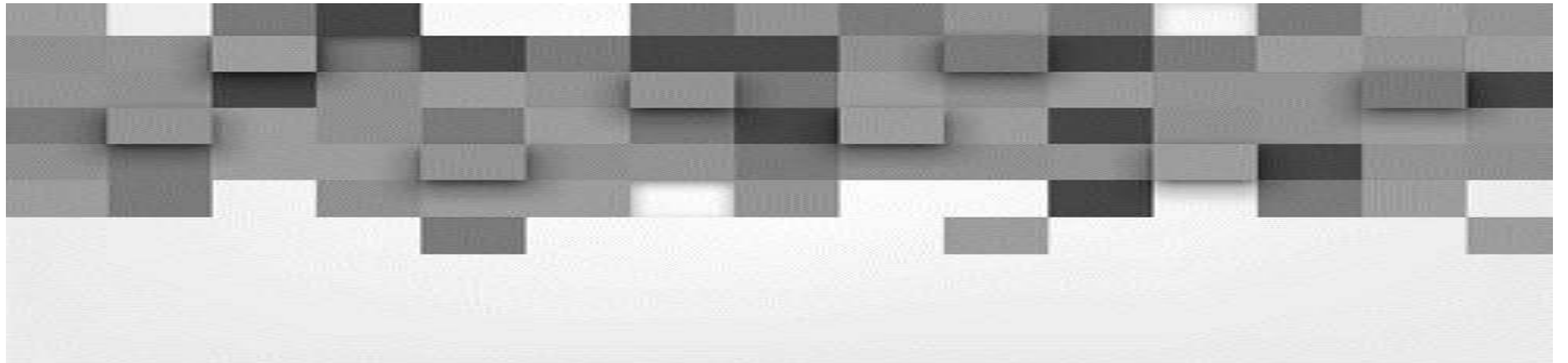

- ✚ Downtown Wilmington consists of several Queen Anne Styles
- ✚ Queen Anne has a consistency of unique shapes, prominent gables, steep/irregular roofing, long and narrow windows, stucco; which is the cement-like structure, shingles, and clapboards. The porches often wrap around to the sides.
- ✚ Georgian style is located in New Bern, NC. The John Wright Stanley house.
- ✚ House was built in the late 1700's
- ✚ It consists of hip roofing, symmetrical design, and built with brick in North Carolina.
- ✚ The picture to the left pinpoints how today we still use these historic designs
- ✚ Bottom left picture is Queen Anne, and right is Georgian

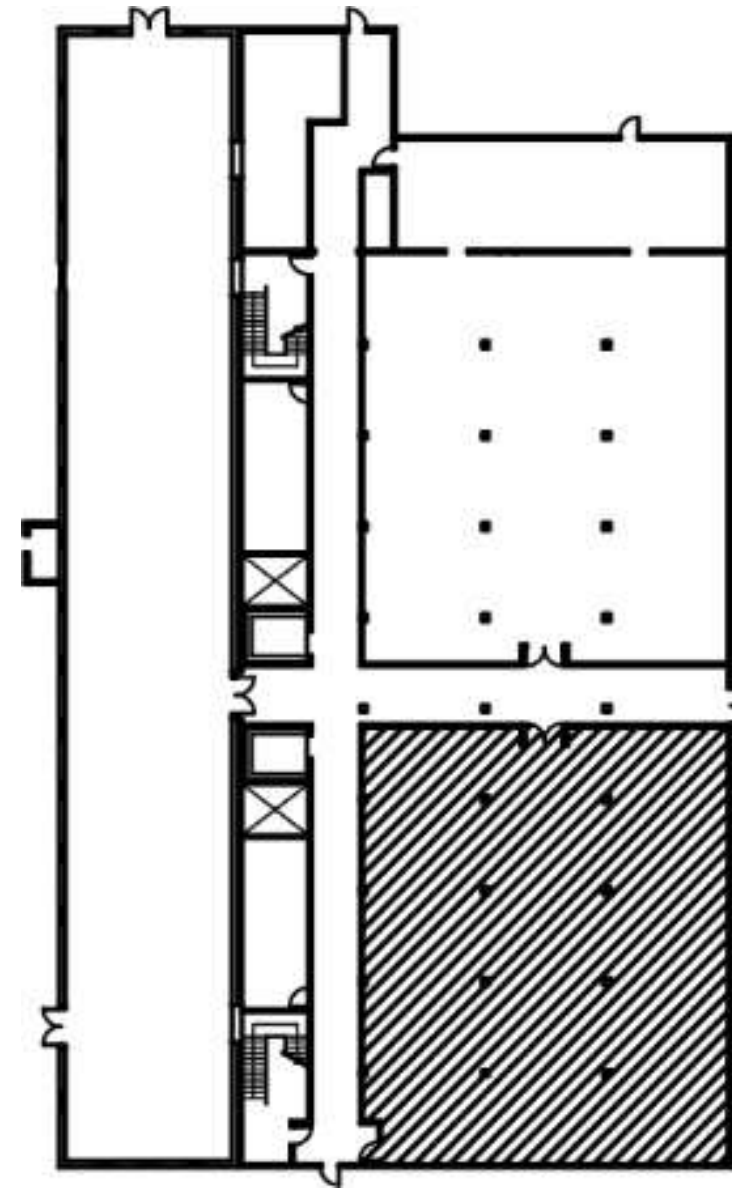

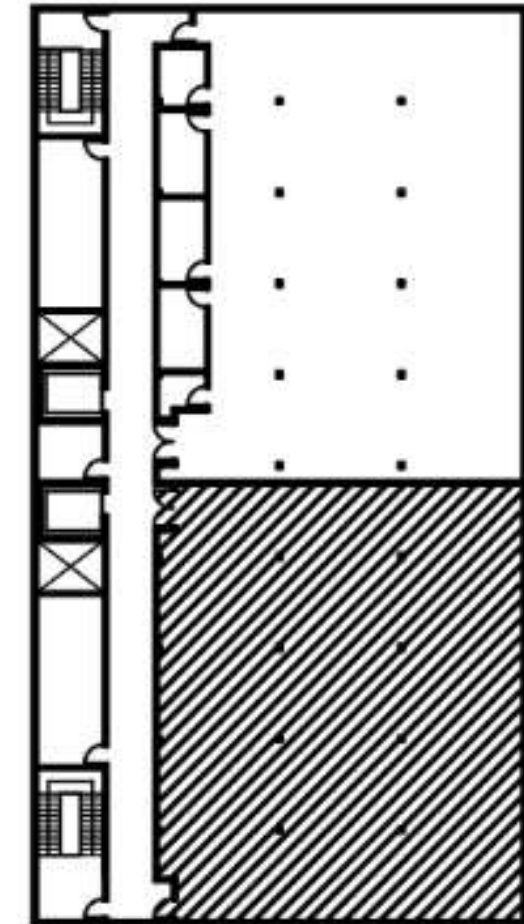

## Client Profile

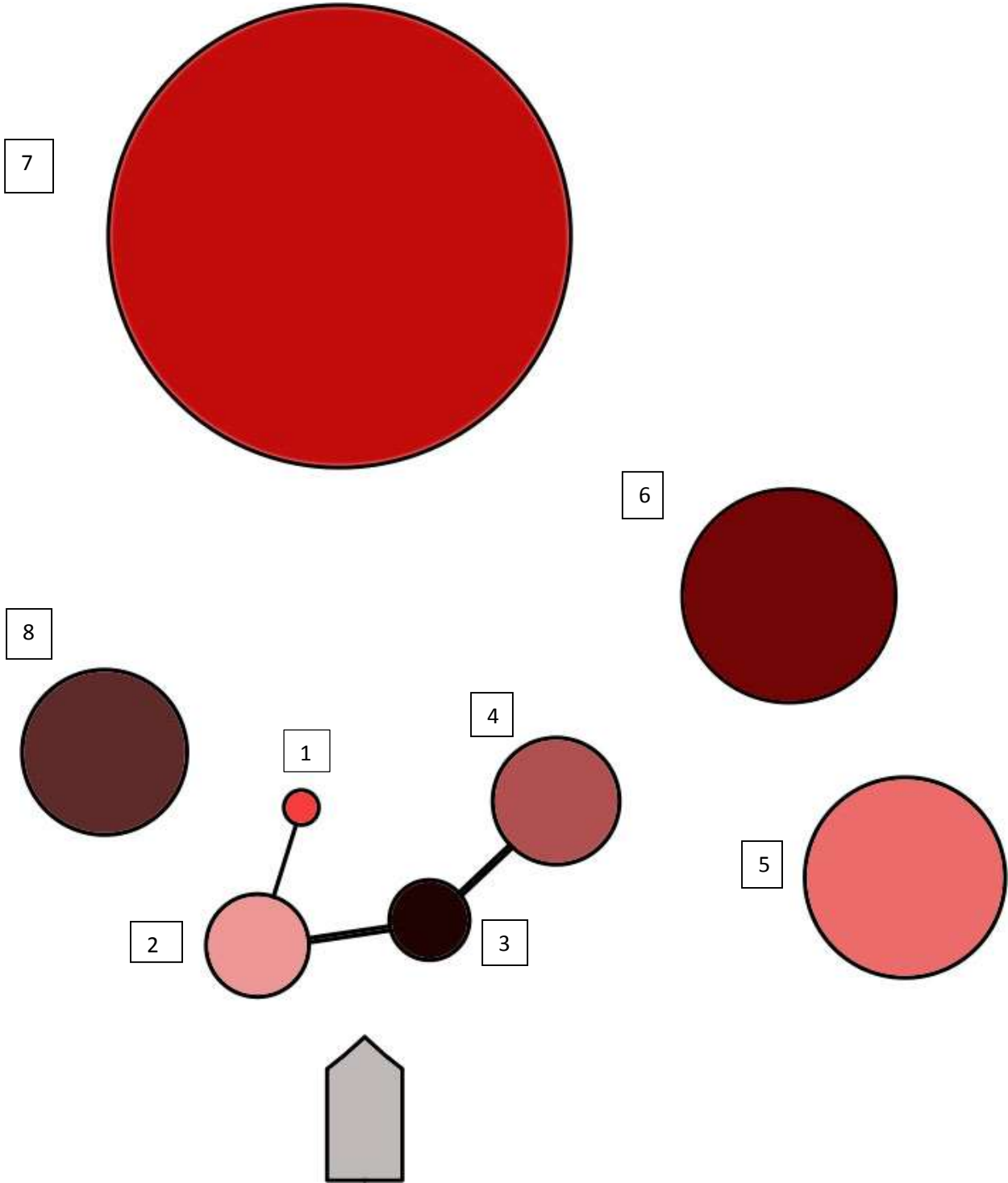
The Gateway Center is a resource center for exploring the design history of the coastal south. Located in Greenville NC, the Center is a partnership between the North Carolina Department of Natural and Cultural Resources and East Carolina University's Department of History, with major funding from the Golden LEAF Foundation.

This state-of-the-art facility allows visitors and scholars to research the rich history of the region, as evidenced by the implements and furnishings used by residents. Research published and programs conducted by the Center paint a detailed portrait of everyday life in the area.

The Center includes:

- Visitor reception area
- Exhibition space
- Meeting rooms with full audio/video capabilities
- Facilities for researchers
- Documentation workroom

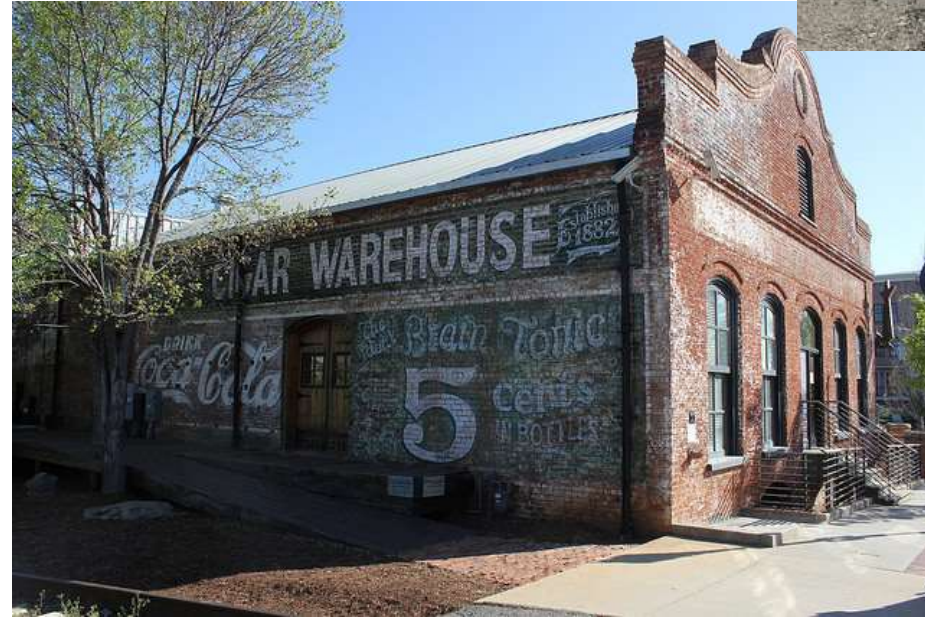




The sun rises in the East, and sets in West. The sunlight receives no direct sunlight. The South receives it continuously.

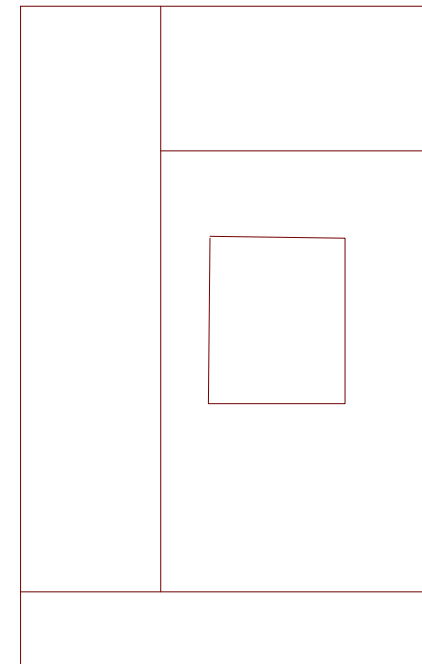
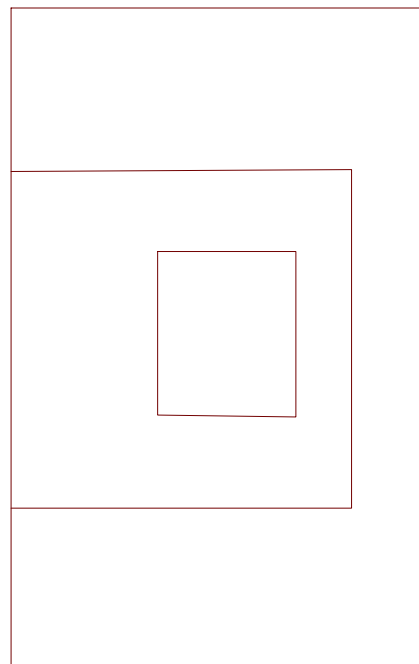
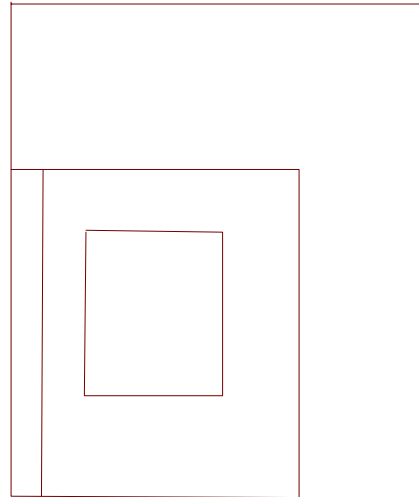
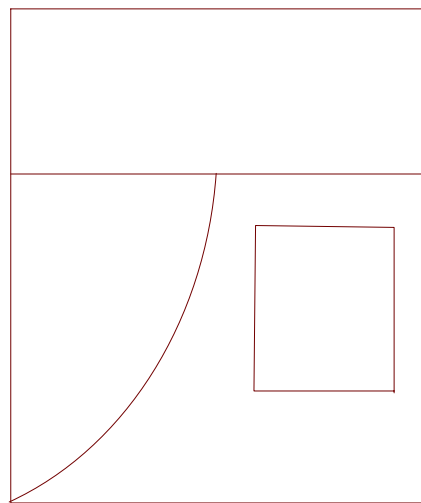

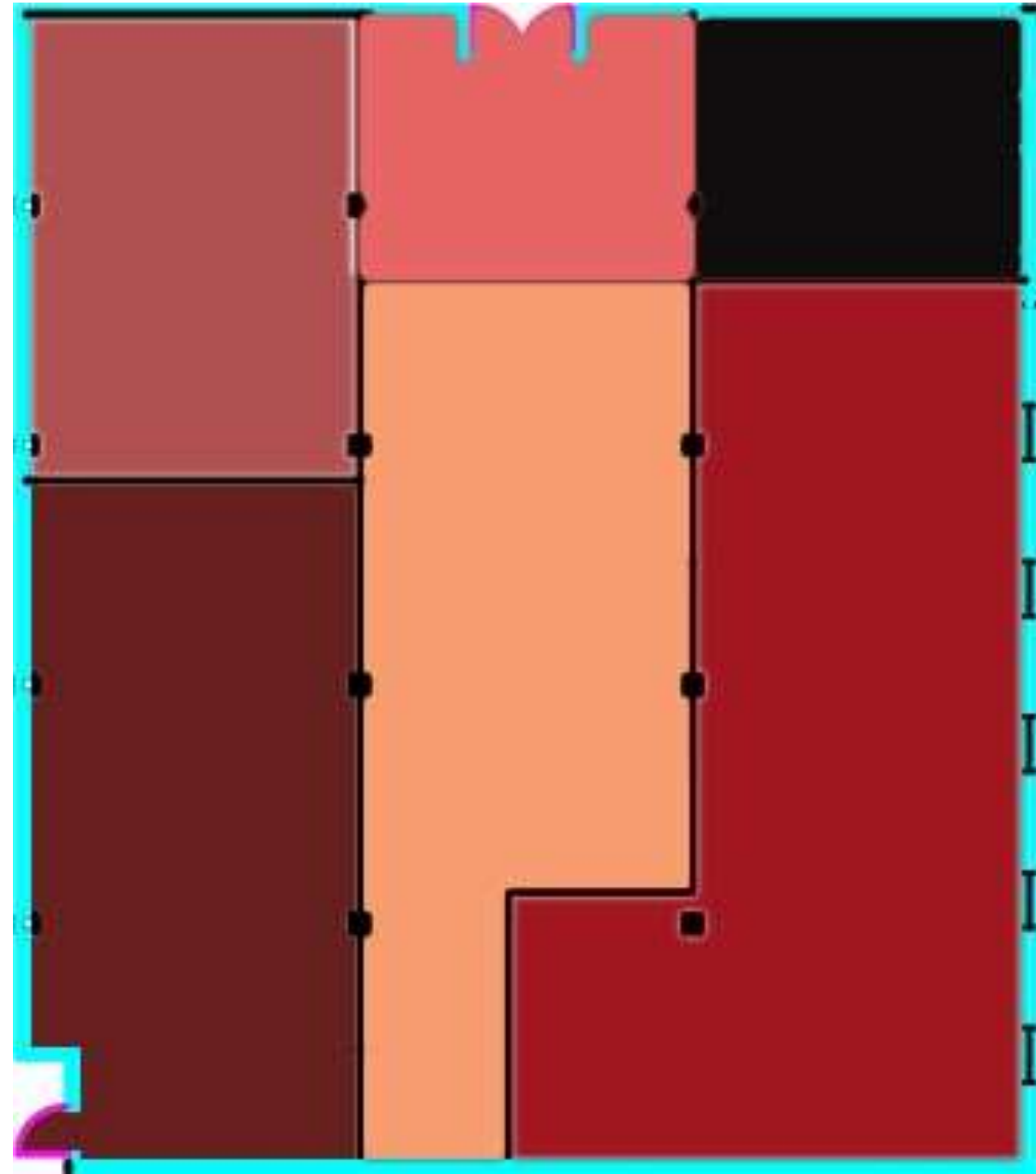
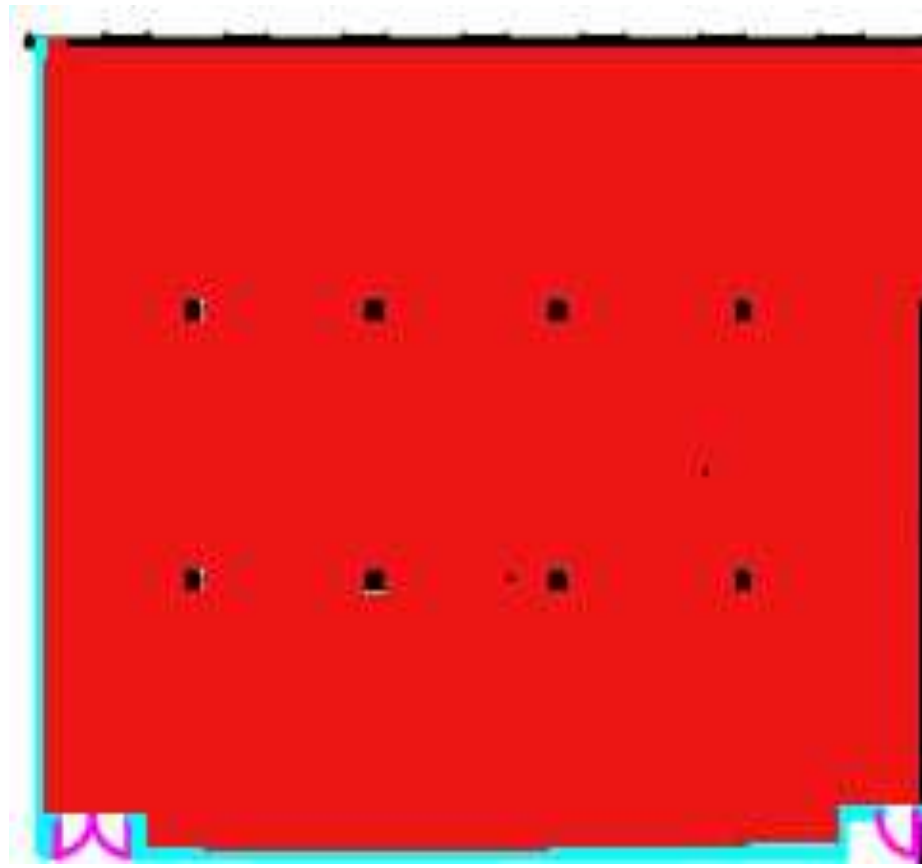


Stair Sketches

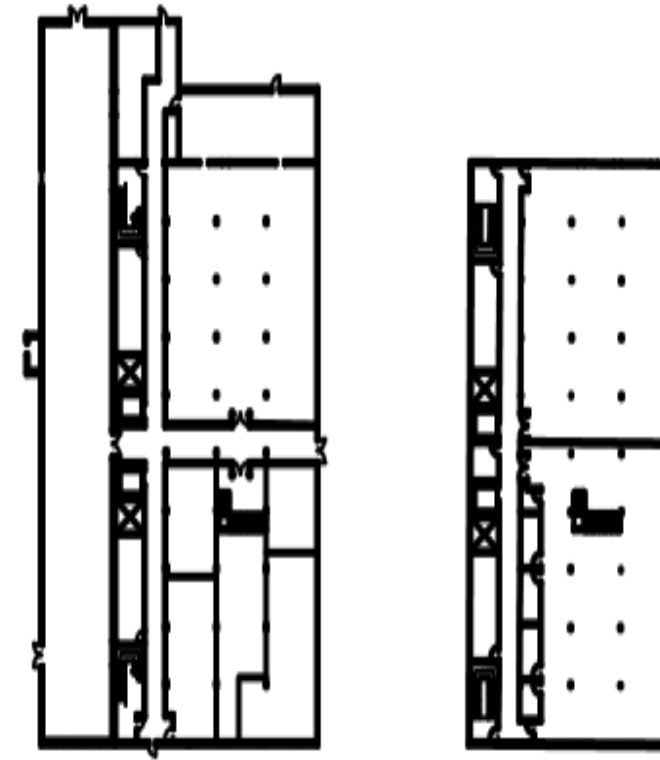
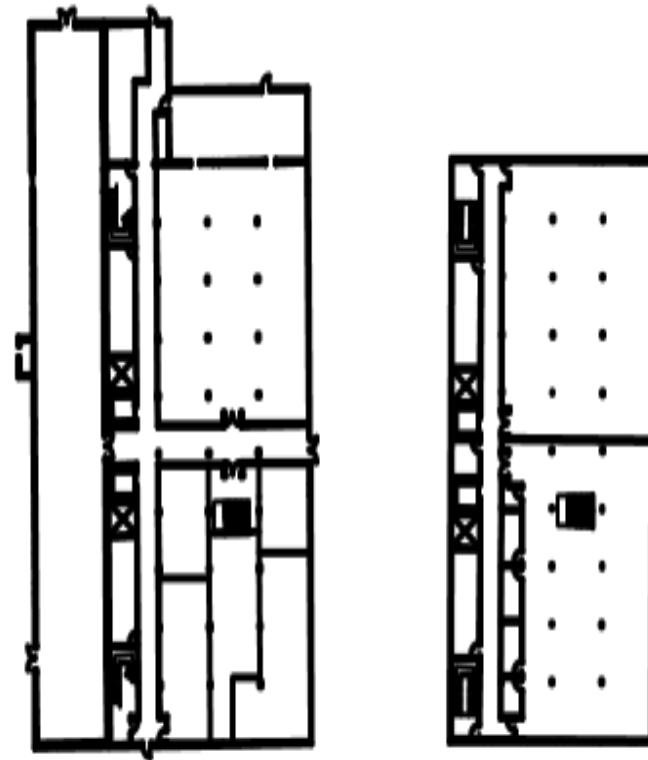
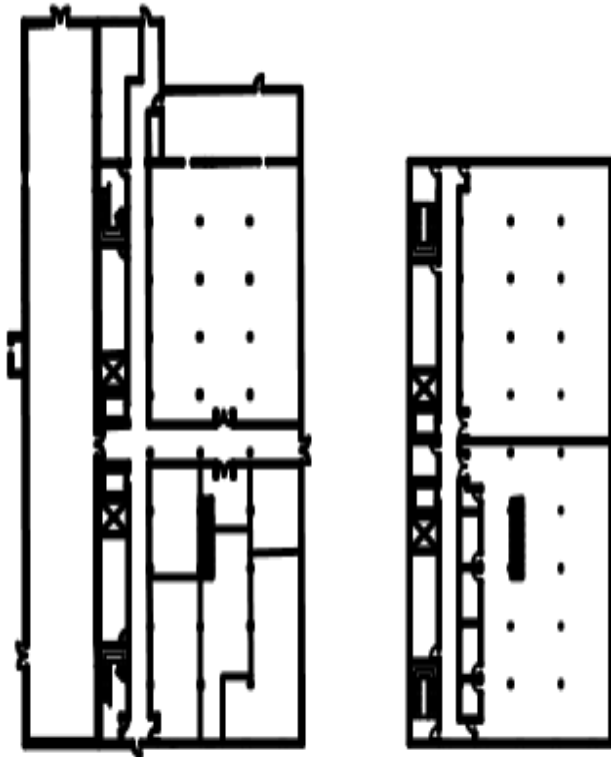


# Downstairs and Upstairs Colored Blocking
