


Figure 2: Infront of site.

Since there are windows only on the second floor, that's the only


way for natural light to enter the space. ——— Morning light

Millennial Campus: ECRIC (East Carolina Research and Innovation Campus)


- Purpose: create jobs for people in the Greenville area and attract people from other areas

- Place for collaboration and sharing ideas


Warehouse District (22.3 acres)

User Profile:




Design Problem Statement:



Floor Plan 1





