

- As life expectancy rises and modern medicine increases the survival rate of those with significant injuries, illnesses, and birth defects, there is a growing interest in universal design.


• The 7 Principles to Universal Design:


- o Principle 1: Equitable Use
 - The design is useful and marketable to people with diverse abilities.
- o Principle 2: Flexibility in Use
 - The design accommodates a wide range of individual preferences and abilities.
- o Principle 3: Simple and Intuitive Use
 - O Use of the design is easy to understand, regardless of the user's experience, knowledge, language skills, or current concentration level.
- o Principle 4: Perceptible Information
 - The design communicates necessary information effectively to the user, regardless of ambient conditions or the user's sensory abilities.
- o Principle 5: Tolerance for Error
 - The design minimizes hazards and the adverse consequences of accidental or unintended actions
- o Principle 6: Low Physical Effort
 - The design can be used efficiently and comfortably and with a minimum of fatigue.
- Principle 7: Size and Space for Approach and Use
 - Appropriate size and space is provided for approach, reach, manipulation, and use regardless of user's body size, posture, or mobility.




