

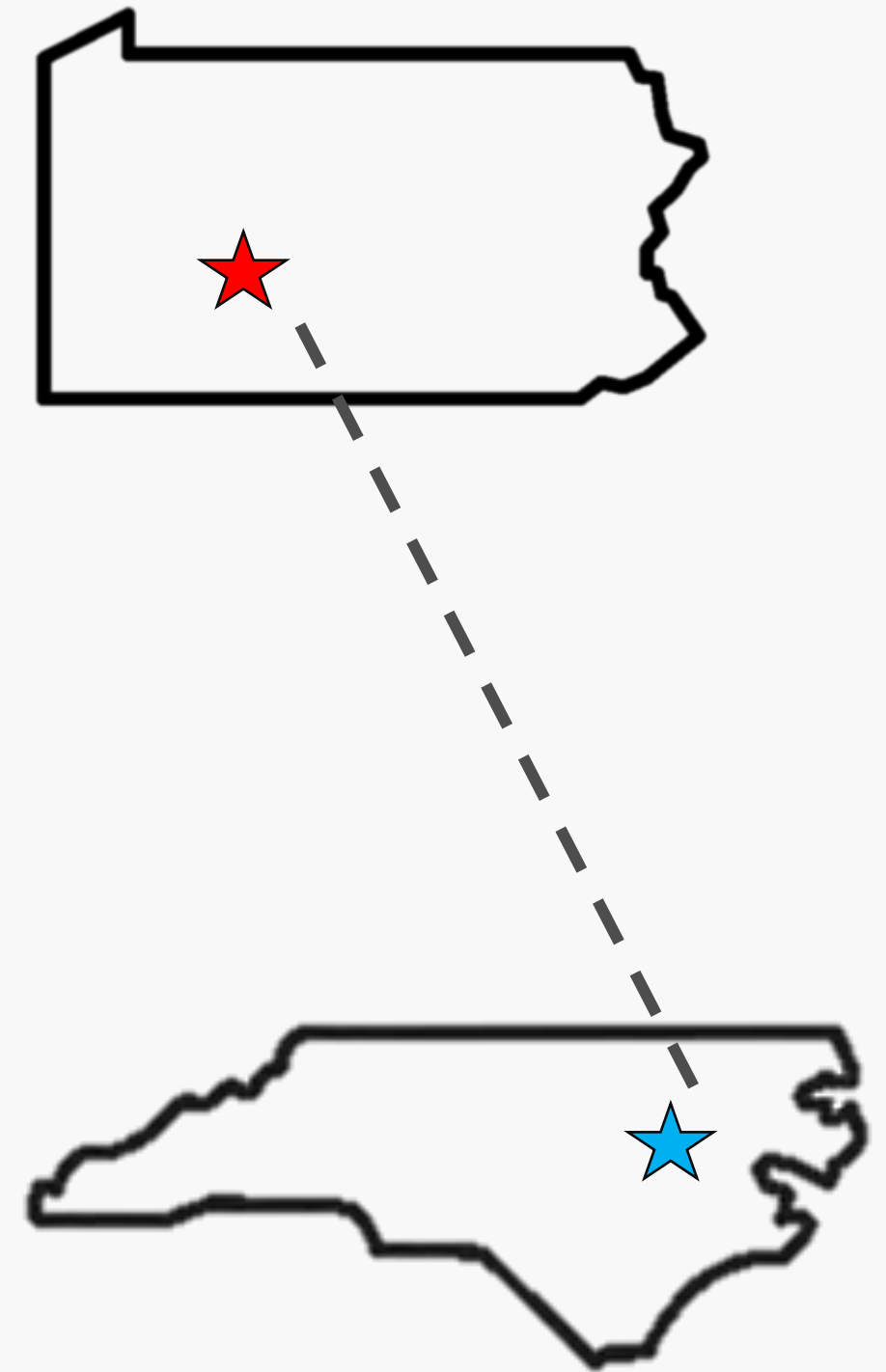

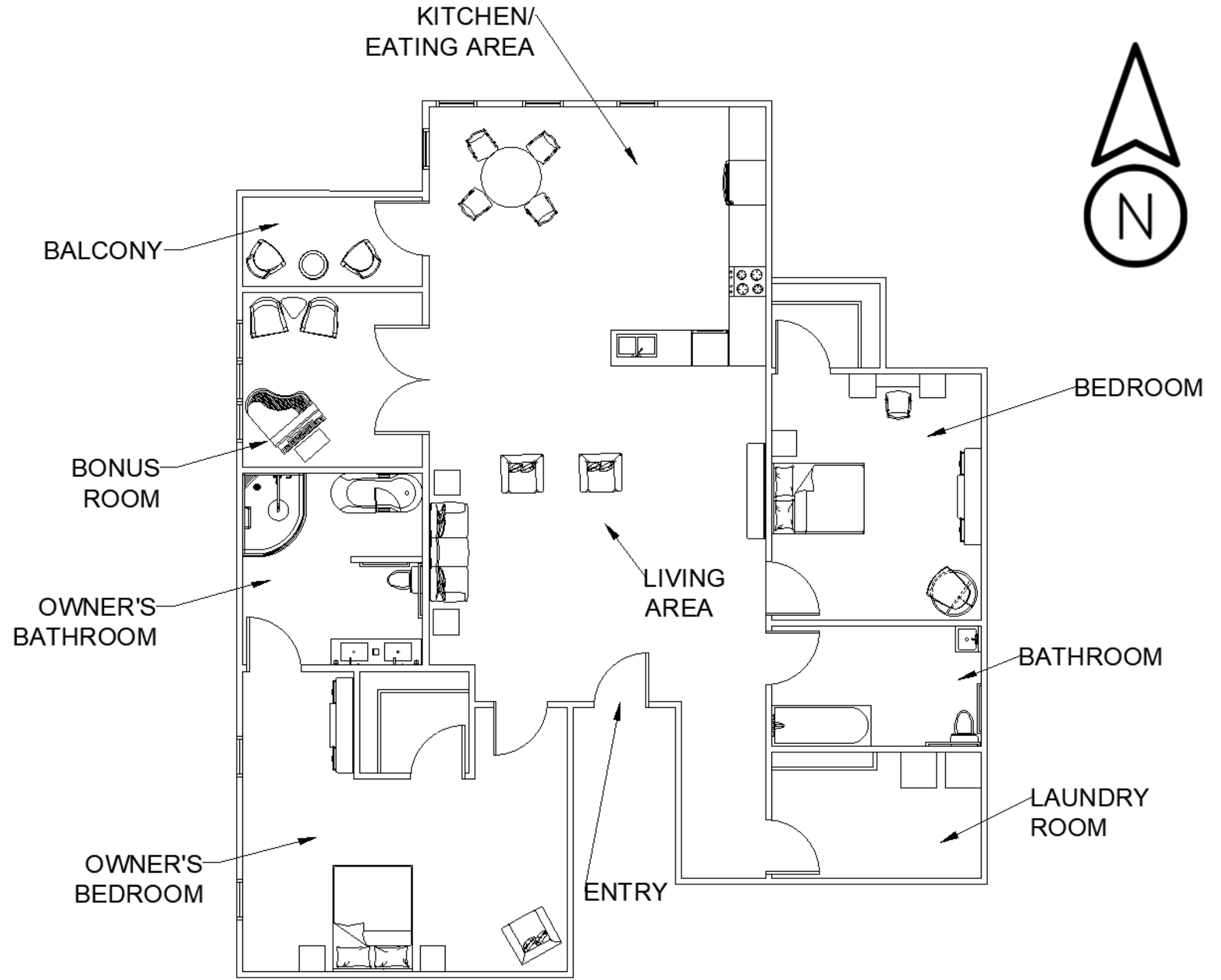
Client Profile

- They want to purchase and upgrade the unit. They would like new furniture and furnishings that will incorporate their styles.

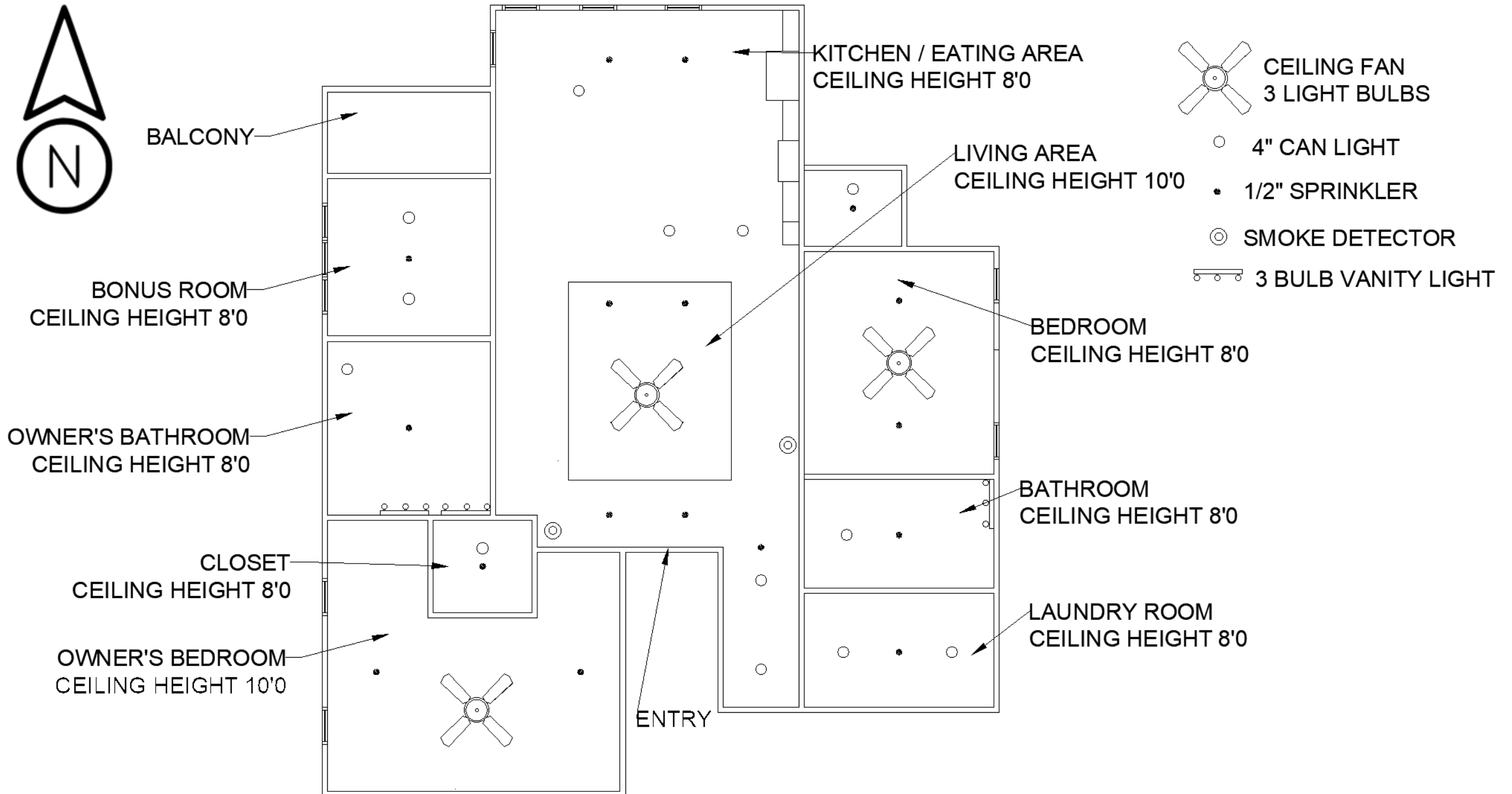


Furniture Plan

Reflected Ceiling Plan (update)



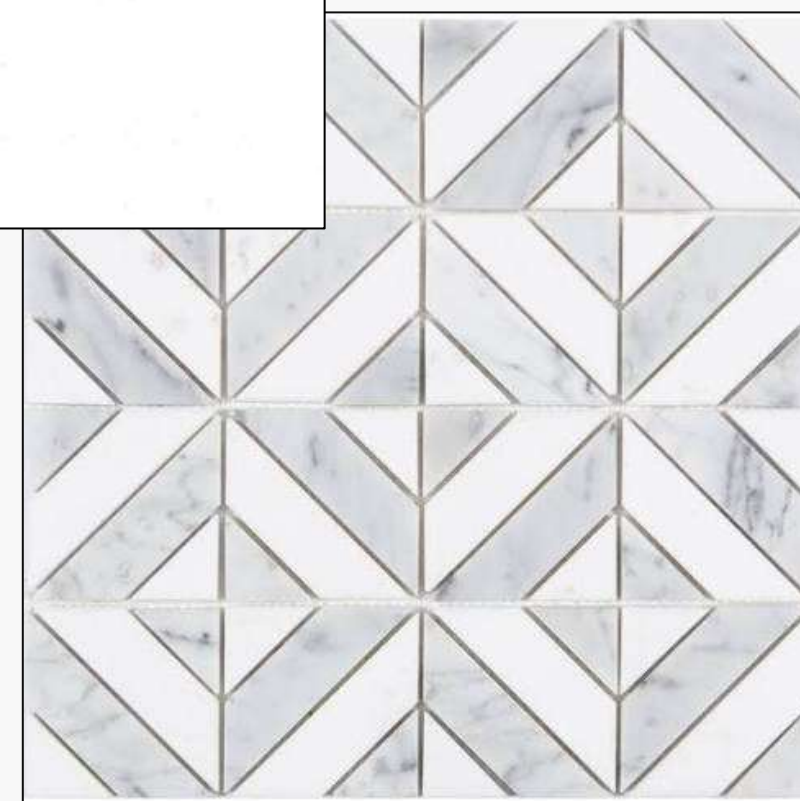
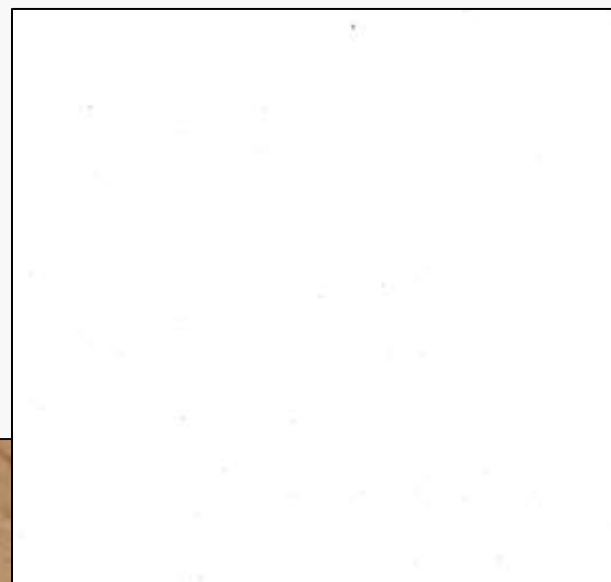

Biedermeier Style

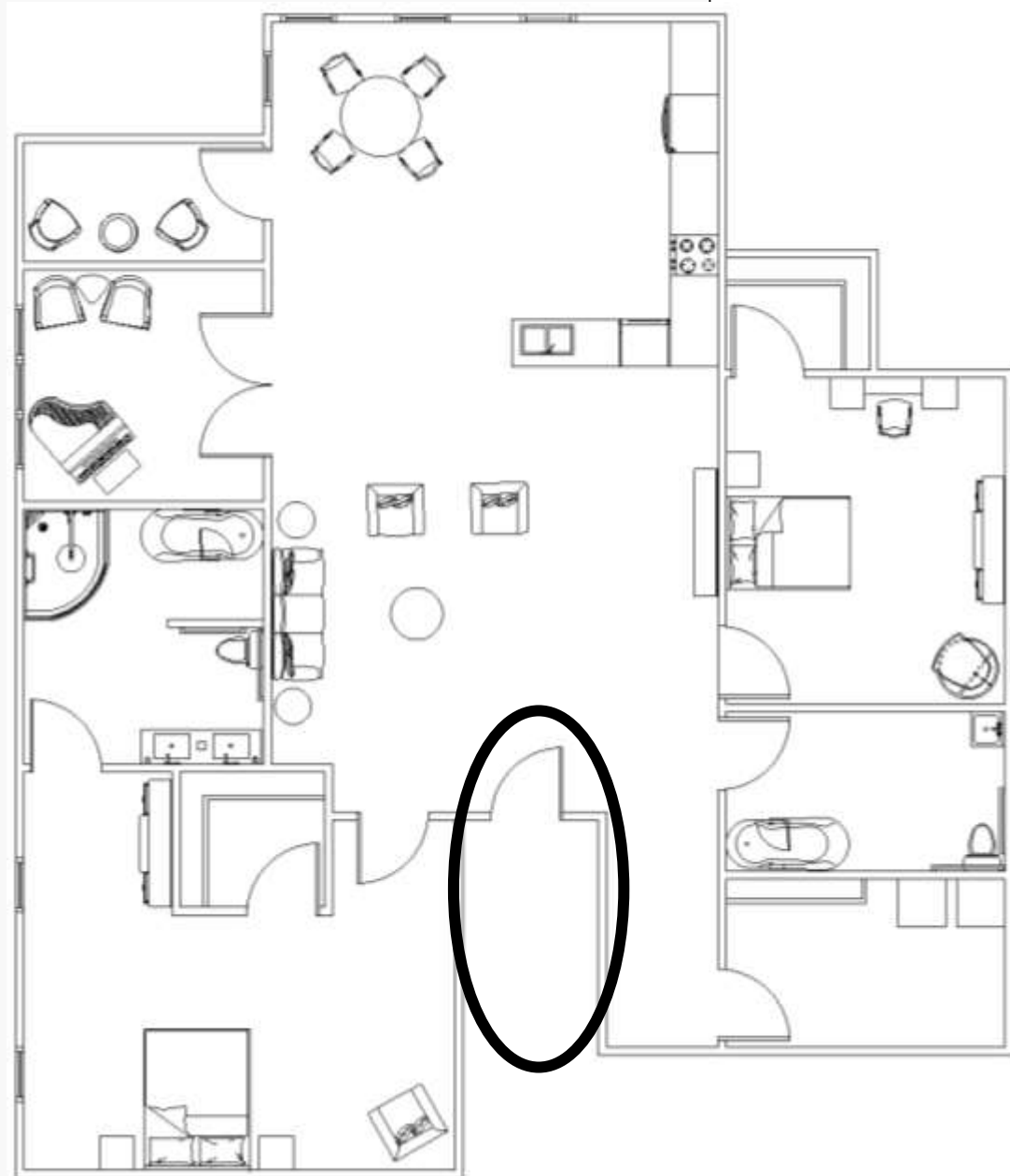

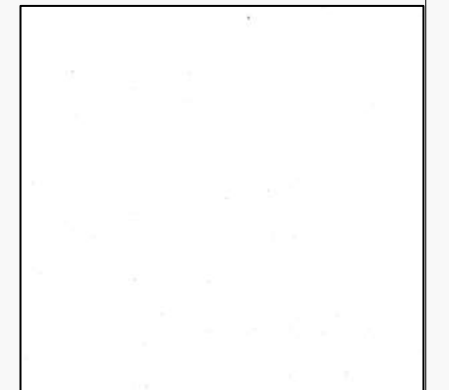

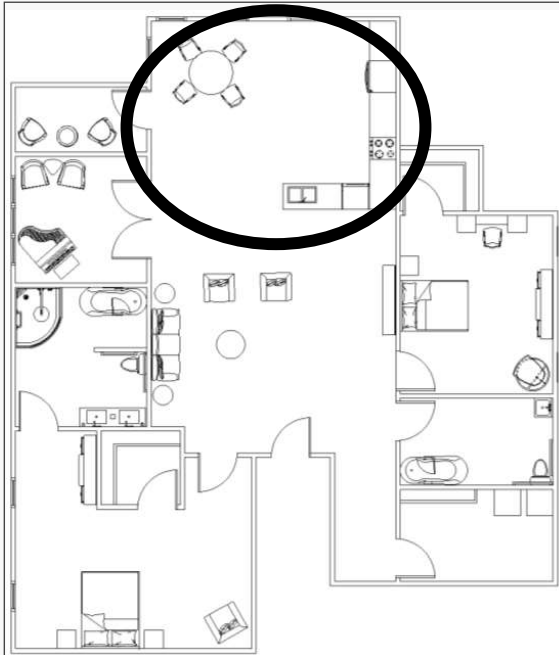

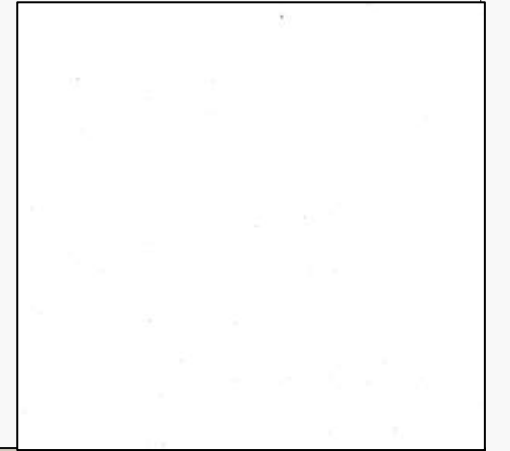

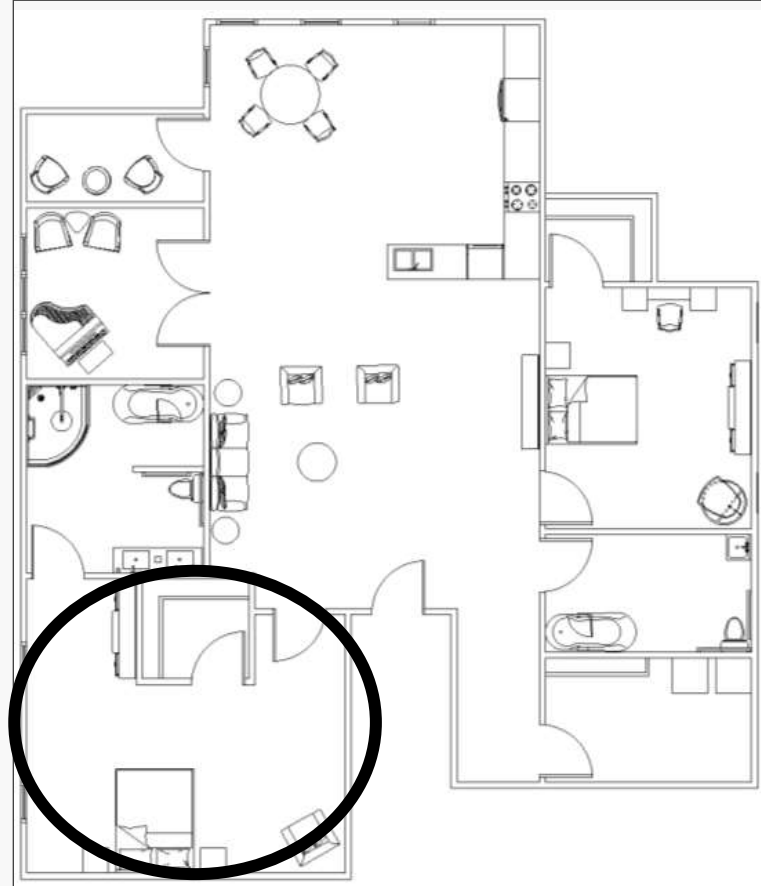
Kitchen & Eating Area Perspective
