

UNIVERSAL DESIGN STRATEGIES:

- ADA COMPLIANT APPLIANCES AND FIXTURES
 COUNTERTOPS AT DIFFERENT HEIGHTS IN BATHROOMS
- EXTRA SPACE THAN REQUIRED BY ADA FOR WHEELCHAIRS
 ROOM FOR APPROPRIATE CIRCULATION IN ENTRY AREA
- ROLL-IN SHOWERS FOR WHEELCHAIRS AND GRAB BARS
- BOTH ELEVATORS AND STAIRWELLS IN THE BUILDING
- No-slip flooring in both bathrooms and kitchen
 Anywhere where the surface could become slippery
- ALL LEVER HANDLES OR POCKET DOORS THAT DO NOT CLOSE ALL THE WAY FOR EASY ACCESS TO GRAB

- COMFORT-HEIGHT TOILETS
- WIDER SIZE DOORWAYS AND ENTRYWAYS
- GRAB BARS AND HAND RAILS IN BATHROOMS AND PUBLIC AREAS
- ONE TOUCHLESS FAUCET IN MASTER BEDROOM AND GUEST BATHROOM

HUMAN BEHAVIOR:

- APARTMENTS AND THE BUILDING AS A WHOLE HAVE FEATURES LIKE GRAB BARS AND HANDRAILS BUT WILL BE DESIGNED IN A WAY WHERE IT IS NOT NOTICEABLE THAT THEY ARE EACH OF THESE.
- LARGE BALCONIES FACING OUTWARD OF EACH APARTMENT PRIVACY FEATURE FROM OTHER TENANTS
- WINDOWS ALSO FACING OUTWARD- NOT ABLE TO BE SEEN BY OTHER TENANTS
- GUEST BEDROOMS FOR FAMILY MEMBERS OF TENANTS
- HIGH END FINISHES/APPLIANCES THAT ARE STILL EASY TO USE
- ENTRYWAY AND HALLWAYS BUILT WITH EXTRA ROOM FOR TURNING CIRCLES
- NATURAL LIGHT THROUGH BOTH BEDROOMS AND LIVING ROOM, WHICH OPENS UP TO THE DINING ROOM AS WELL
