
- Design Storyline




Pat, with his love of Historical styles, requested an anthropometric chair in the style of a Louis XVI chair his grandparents had when he was a child. Using anthropometric measurements, I created a chair with dimensions suitable for Pat and Fran, whose measurements fall between the 5th and 50th percentiles.

THE BACK OF THE CHAIR IS TALL ENOUGH TO GIVE EACH USER PROPER SUPPORT, AS WELL AS A SLIGHT RECLINE FOR COMFORT. THE ARMS OF THE CHAIR ARE A MEASUREMENT THAT ASSURES THAT THE WEIGHT OF THE USER'S ARMS IS SUPPORTED BY THE CHAIR AND NOT THE USER'S BACK, WHICH IS ESPECIALLY IMPORTANT FOR AN AGING COUPLE. THE CHAIR IS ALSO AT A HEIGHT THAT WILL ALLOW THE COUPLE TO SIT DOWN AND GET UP EASILY.

SINCE PAT AND FRAN HAVE GRANDCHILDEN THAT VISIT OFTEN, I ADDED A GLIDER TO THE BOTTOM OF THE CHAIR AND ADDED UPHOLSTERY TO COVER THE MECHANISM. THEY PLAN TO PUT THE CHAIR IN THE GUEST BEDROOM SO THEIR GRANDCHILDREN CAN BE ROCKED TO SLEEP.
