I woke up one morning and my mom said that her and my dad had a surprise for me. This surprise changed my life forever.




My parents got me a therapy dog. His name is Dexter and he is a 3-year-old boxer.

I follow Dana wherever she goes. She sometimes has a really hard time getting out of bed. She just always says how today isn't a good day, but then I lick her face all over and make her get up.








up so I barked and barked until a neighbor was able to come over and help her up. She called me her hero that day. I don't really know what that means but I think it's a good thing.

Sometimes I think about what I would do without Dexter. I feel myself becoming me again. I'm happy again. I don't feel like an amputee.































RENDERED FLOOR PLAN
