

Logic

First Level

- Foyer Entries should be a minimum of 5' x 5' for adequate wheelchair turnaround
- Kitchen Universal Design suggests a minimum of 60" turning clearance for the use of the space to feel comfortable and maximize efficiency
- Living / Dining / Master Bed / Screened in Porch / Sunroom – After furniture is placed within the space, there is a required a 5' x 5' turn around space around each piece
- Master Bath / Guest Bath needs to exceed 5' x 8' to accommodate comfortable turn around in a wheelchair or other means of mobility assistance with an aid or independently
- Master Closet / Guest Closet
- Utility Closet








Bubble Diagram: 1



Blocking Diagram: 1








Master Bed Elevations

















Guest Bed and Bath Elevations








Axonometric View






Section through Central Corridor






Full Building Floorplan







Universal Design Strategies


ENTRY; Each entry into each unit accessible from the public corridor has a bench that allows an individual to place items on the bench surface, so when they pick them up they don't; have to bend all the way down.

Across from washer / dryer there is a 30" counter for folding clothes

Each shower includes grab bars, a bench and can be walked in All door openings have 18" of space on the pull side of the door

All door openings are at least 36" wide

All sinks in the bathroom and the bedrooms are directly attached to the wall, with no base cabinets, allowing for a wheelchair to comfortably access the sink.
