The **NCI Communications Fellowship (NCF)** offers highly-qualified graduate students and recent graduate degree recipients a one-year fellowship. ### Eligibility

- Current or recent graduate degree student
- Current or final GPA of 3.0 or higher
- US Citizen or US permanent resident
- Communications education/background

Fellows are placed in NCI offices at one of three Maryland campuses: the Main Campus in Bethesda; the Shady Grove Building in Rockville; or the NCI campus in Frederick.
