**Prewriting:** Think about what you believe to be five (5) characteristics of an ethical teacher. In your journal, reflect on teachers you have encountered who have embodied these traits. Have you been taught by educators who have gone against these standards? Elaborate. Your journal will be due Monday, December 8, the last day of class.

**Annotated bibliography:** Review the literature on ethical teaching standards and create an annotated bibliography containing twenty (20) resources that examine ethical codes and principles for K-12 teachers. Two (2) must be primary sources.

**Recommendation:** For clarity of focus, you may wish to focus on a particular grade or a specific discipline. Your primary sources should be interviews of professionals in the field of K-12 teaching.

A successful project will contain a clear, concise summary and evaluation of each source's main ideas and will include a logical explanation on how you will utilize each source in your research paper. Your audience members are your peers in the College of Education.

A "how-to" handout and a sample project are available on Bb. Use academic secondary sources, which can be found on Google Scholar and on vetted databases.

**Format**

- Your document must have 1" margins and contain your name, my name, the course number/time, and the date stacked in the left-hand side of the first page.
- Include the word References, which should be centered.
- Use a clear 12-point font, and double-space your entire bibliography. Do not put extra spaces between citations, but be sure to use "hanging indents."
- Ten (10) points will be deducted if your formatting is incorrect.
- You must use the 6<sup>th</sup> edition of APA style. (See OWL APA for complete formatting rules)
