**The edited project must be presented in a folder that contains at least three (3) rough drafts.**

**Research project:** According to the literature, what is “ethics in teaching”? Begin your 5- to 7-page paper by synthesizing the definitions you encountered in your research and creating a strong thesis. Then, discuss five (5) characteristics of an ethical teacher and their importance in the K-12 classroom, utilizing strong transitions between ideas. Your conclusion will include an assessment of yourself as a future teacher.

Cite all of your sources in your text! Your paper must contain at least ten (10) outside sources, including the required two (2) interviews.

You must attach a reference page to your essay. This list will contain many of the sources you included in your Annotated Bibliography. (Remove the annotations and the stacked information before attaching the list!)

**NOTE:** If no reference page is attached, your assignment will automatically receive a zero (0). You will not be given a chance to submit the reference list separately. Pay attention!

**Reviewing what you have learned:** Return to your journal, arguing whether you believe ethics can be taught or merely codified. Your journal will be due Monday, December 8, the last day of class.

**IMPORTANT DATES**

W, October 1

Your completed annotated bibliography is due by noon. No exceptions.

W, October 8

Take to class typed transcripts of your interviews. You will discuss these in groups. Five (5) points will be deducted from your final project if you are absent or if you do not have these items.

W, October 15

Take a rough draft—containing at least your introduction, thesis, and notes on the five (5) characteristics you will be exploring—to class for peer review. Five (5) points will be deducted from your final project if you are absent or if do not have a rough draft.

W, October 29

Your revised paper and reference list are due by noon. No exceptions. Really. Your folder must also contain at least three (3) rough drafts.

**Format**

- Your document must have 1” margins and contain your name, my name, the course number/time, and the date stacked in the left-hand side of the first page.
- Include the title References, which should be centered.
- Use a clear 12-point font, and double-space. Do not put extra spaces between paragraphs, but be sure to indent each paragraph.
- Ten (10) points will be deducted if your formatting is incorrect.
- You must use the 6<sup>th</sup> edition of APA style. (See OWL APA for complete formatting rules)
- Did you miss the part about having a reference list? Read this document again.
